- 3.) Charter Fishing Activities – No special gear required. Sun protection suggested. (hat, sun glasses, sunscreen)
- 4.) Canoe Trip - Gear for a night away from camp such as clothes, personal items, sleeping bag, hammock, tent, etc.

- ☐ Underwear (extra just in case)
- ☐ Swimsuit and swim towel
- ☐ Poncho or rain jacket
- ☐ Hat
- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Dirty laundry bag
- ☐ Shoes/ boots (opened-toed and open-healed shoes not allowed)
- ☐ Water/Shower shoes
- ☐ Bible or prayer book
- ☐ Scoutbook
- ☐ Notebook and Pencils (needed for class)
- ☐ Tent, Tarp, Tent Pegs, Hammer
- ☐ Cot, air mattress, or sleeping Pad
- ☐ Pillow, Lightweight sleeping bag or sheets and a blanket
- ☐ Battery-powered fan for inside tent
- ☐ Soap and shampoo
- ☐ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ☐ Bath towels and washcloth
- ☐ Gold bond powder
- ☐ Bug spray
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Personal first aid kit
- ☐ Money for trading post (No Large Bills)
- ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ☐ Reusable water bottle
- ☐ Camp Chair
- ☐ Pocket knife (If you have the "Totin' Chit")
- ☐ Fishing rod and tackle
- ☐ Day Pack (backpack) to carry rain gear, water bottle, notebook and pencils, swimming gear, etc. needed during the day.
- ☐ Plastic bin with lid required for any food/snacks in the campsite/tent
