



## **Crosscraft Spring Regatta 2024**

NP Rules that are not ground for protest by a boat. This changes Racing Rule of Sailing 60.1(a) and 63.1

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta shall be governed by 'the rules' as defined in the 2021 2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 In the event of conflict, the **Sailing Instructions (SI)**, and any amendments thereof shall take precedence over the Notice of Race. This changes RRS 63.7.
- 1.3 No national authority prescriptions shall apply.
- 1.4 The first three sentences of RRS 61.1(a) shall be changed to "The protesting boat shall inform the other boat at the first reasonable opportunity. When her protest will concern an incident in the racing area, she shall hail 'Protest'. She shall inform the Race Committee at the finishing line immediately after finishing of the boat/s being protested. If the boat retires before finishing, she shall inform the Race Committee via the official boat closest to her at the same time as advising that she has retired".
- 1.5 [NP] [DP] RRS 40.1 will apply whilst afloat.
- 1.6 RRS Appendix T Arbitration will apply and is changed as follows:

  A post-race penalty is a Scoring Penalty equal to 30% of the score for DNF, or 50 % of the difference between the boat's finishing position in the race and the score for DNF, whichever is less. The Scoring Penalty is calculated as stated in RRS 44.3(c). However, RRS 44.1(a) applies.
- 1.7 English is the Official Language of this regatta. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.'

#### 2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Competitors might be required to display event advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all sailors duly registered with their respective National Association, in any of the following classes:

#### **Optimist Class:**

**Open Category:** Optimist sailors in the Open Category may register in either of the following two Divisions: **Senior Division -** Boys and Girls born between 2012 and 2009 (12 – 15yrs).

**Cadet Division -** Boys and Girls born between 2016 and 2013 (8 - 11)yrs) whose scores shall be extracted unchanged from the overall results of the Open Category.

#### OR

#### **Novice Category**

Boys and Girls born between 2016 and 2010(8 - 14yrs) **and** have not yet been racing for more than twelve (12) months.

#### **ILCA Classes**:

**ILCA 7 Class** 

**ILCA 6 Class** 

ILCA 4 Class - No age restrictions will apply.



#### **TOPPER 4.2 and 5.3**

RS FEVA XL Class - No age restrictions will apply

#### **SB20**

Event registration fees shall be as follows:

#### An additional late entry fee of Eu10 will be payable after the 10th April 2024.

Eligible competitors shall submit their entry by completing the online registration via the following link: <a href="https://bscsailing.club/register-1">https://bscsailing.club/register-1</a>

Online registration deadline is till 1800hrs, 10<sup>th</sup> April 2024. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Authority and are subject to the specified late entry fee.

Registration for entry may close earlier at the discretion of Organising Authority. No registrations without payment shall be accepted.

#### 4. ON SITE REGISTRATION

4.1 On-site registration shall be made at the Race Office only by the respective coach or support person within the below on-site registration time windows. Only coaches or support persons shall be allowed to enter the Race Office.

- 4.2 It is also mandatory for all competitors under the age of eighteen (18) to be accompanied by a coach or support person whilst ashore. A Parent Consent Form must be duly filled in by the parent or guardian of the minor, to be then handed over by the coach or support person during the On-site registration time. The Parent Consent Form can be found in Appendix III or can be downloaded from the event website.
- 4.3 Competitors under the age of eighteen (18) shall also be supported by a coach or on water support person whilst afloat. The maximum coach / On water support person to competitor ratio shall be according to class and not exceeding the below ratios:

Class	Max coach / on water support person to competitor ratio
Optimist Class - Novice Category	1:8
Optimist Class - Open Category	1:10
ILCA Classes	1:12
RS FEVA XL Class	1:5
Topper	1:10

During the online registration process, competitors under the age of eighteen (18) shall be required to fill in the name of their coach / on water support person whilst afloat. Further Online Registrations shall be



automatically rejected as soon as the registered coach / on water support person responsibility quota is exceeded.

4.4 During the on-site registration, the coach or support person shall be required to show the following documents:

Duly filled and signed Parent/Guardian Consent Form for every competitor under his or her responsibility who are under the age of eighteen (18).

Evidence of competitor's date of birth (passport, National Identity Card).

#### 5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 A maximum of six (6) races in each class are being scheduled for the whole event.
- 5.2 A maximum of four (4) races per day shall be sailed on any one day.
- 5.3 No warning signal shall be made later than 1630hrs on the last day of the regatta.
- 5.4 On the first day of the regatta, a briefing for coaches and team leaders shall be held not later than 90 minutes before the first warning signal

#### 6. MEASUREMENT

The Race Committee may check a boat's racing equipment at any time during the regatta and may also request a valid measurement certificate.

#### 7. COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 7.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official Online Notice Board (ONB) at https://racingrulesofsailing.org/events/8360
- 7.2 A copy of the sailing instructions shall be posted on the ONB by 0900hrs on the first day of the regatta.

#### 8. VENUE

- 8.1 The launching and storage of boats shall be from the Birżebbuga Sailing Club premises and slipway at Wied II-Buni, Birżebbuġa, Malta.
- 8.2 The designated racing area shall be in and around the waters of Marsaxlokk Bay as illustrated in Appendix I. The race area and the course configuration will solely depend on each racing day's prevailing weather conditions.



#### 9. COURSES

The course layouts shall be based around a trapezoid or windward/leeward courses, these shall be issued with the Sailing Instructions and explained during the briefing for coaches and team leaders.

#### 10. SUPPORT BOATS

- 10.1 Support persons (team leaders, coaches, parents, guardians and other support personnel) intending to helm support boats, shall hold a valid motorboat handling licence.
- 10.2 A maximum of two **(2)** Coaches / On water support persons shall be allowed to share same support boat if the maximum support boat to competitor responsibility ratio of 1:12 is not exceeded.
- 10.3 Coaches / on water support persons shall ensure that the on-water support provided for their team is adequate for the ability of their sailors according to the prevailing conditions during the regatta.
- 10.4 Support or Coach boats shall be at least 4 metres in length with a minimum engine capacity of 25HP. Teams shall ensure that the vessel is seaworthy and correctly registered and insured with the competent authorities.
- 10.5 Support or Coach boats shall have basic safety equipment whilst afloat, this shall include a functional VHF marine transceiver set, line and anchor sized appropriately for the size of the support boat and PFDs for all passengers on-board.
- 10.6 As a Safety requirement, Support Boat "Kill Cords" must be always attached to the support boat driver whilst the engine is switched ON.

#### 11. STORAGE OF BOATS

- 11.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places at the club boat park starting from the evening of Friday 14th April 2024 onwards.
- 11.2 To better organize the regatta venue ashore, all boat rigging and car or trailer parking shall be within the designated areas in front of the BSC clubhouse as illustrated in Appendix II.

#### 12. Prizes

12.1 Prizes will be awarded to the **first, second** and **third** placed crews in each of the following categories:

**Optimist**: Overall: Seniors, Cadets and Novice category.

Females: Seniors, Cadets and Novice category.

**ILCA**: Overall in each ILCA constituted Classes.

Females in each ILCA constituted Classes.

RS Feva Class: Overall Topper: Overall

- 12.2 In the event of less than four **(4)** registered boats in each constituted class or category, only the prize for **1**<sup>st</sup> place shall be awarded.
- 12.3 The prize giving presentation shall be held at the BSC Clubhouse after the last race on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

#### 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY



- 13.1 Competitors and support team members participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 3, "Decision to Race". The organizing authority will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 13.2 The Organizing Authority and any other party involved in the organization of the regatta accept no liability whatsoever for any injury, damage, loss, or claim whether personal or material, incurred by or inflicted to participants before, during or after the regatta.
- 13.3 The fact that the race committee will provide rescue boats will not remove from competitors the responsibility they have accepted by participating in this regatta.
- 13.4 By launching, competitors are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for exposing themselves and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event. Additionally, by launching, they are also confirming that their boats are sound and seaworthy for the weather conditions whilst racing, properly fitted out according to the class rules design and regulations.
- 13.5 It is the competitors' responsibility to familiarize themselves with any risks specific to the venue or this regatta drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for this venue or event, and to attend any safety briefings held for the event.

#### 14. INSURANCE

- 14.1 Insurance is mandatory. The owner or charterer of a boat intending to take part in this regatta shall hold a valid third-party liability insurance policy with a minimum cover of 1,500,000Eur or equivalent thereof in any other currency.
- 14.2 Each competitor is wholly and exclusively responsible for third party liability insurance on the boat that he or she is sailing and for his or her personal accident and health insurance.

#### 15. MEDIA RIGHTS

15.1 By participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants the Organising Authority and the event Sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show at their discretion any still or motion pictures, live, taped or filmed on television and other reproductions of him or her during the event, and of all his or her material related to the event, without any right of compensation.



## **Racing Areas**




The areas A, B and C are the designated Racing Areas for this regatta.



#### **APPENDIX II**

#### **BOAT AND CAR PARKING AREA ALLOCATION**



In order to facilitate boat and car traffic management whilst ashore

- All boat rigging shall take place within the areas marked in RED. On the first day of the regatta, every team shall be allocated a specified boat rigging area within the red boat rigging zones.
- No boats shall be rigged on the sandy beach.
- Except for launching or retrieval of ribs, the slipway and road leading to the slipway shall be designated as a No Parking Zone.
- Any movement of boats to the launching areas shall only be permitted after the appropriate signal is displayed on the BSC flagpole.
- All boat launching trolleys will be stacked on the concrete platform by the beach master, helpers, respective team leaders and coaches and helpers.
- All car and trailer parking shall be within the other unmarked areas.
