Quarterly Business Meeting:

The Building & Grounds Team with the Budget & Finance Team present the following as a motion to be voted on at the Quarterly Business Conference, Sunday, May 17. **Exterior Door I**, on Pine Street, after many years of use the door needs replacement. We received the best bid for a 42'' wide single door, casing replacement and standard safety panic bar, (like Door C at the Preschool entrance): Convenient Glass Service, Inc door bid \$7,250. The Errol Briggerman Memorial Fund, \$1,160 will be used. The remaining balance of \$6,090, would come from Funding The Future funds.

The Building & Grounds Team with the Budget & Finance Team present the following as a motion to be voted on at the Quarterly Business Conference, Sunday, May 17. **Replacing the flooring in rooms 114 and 116**, located in the children’s (preschool) area. The current flooring is original from 1977 when the Education building was completed: A&B Carpets and Interiors bid includes current tile removal and prep, commercial grade LVT, installation and new base molding for \$6,807. The Weekday Preschool will pay 50% of the cost. The remaining balance, \$3,403.50, would come from Funding The Future funds.

Several families expressed an interest in our youth program. Thank you to Jeanne Poole for managing the clothes giveaway.
