The Building & Grounds Team and the Budget & Finance Team recommend replacing the flooring in room 115 located in the

children's (preschool) area. The current flooring is original from 1977 when the Education building was completed. A&B Carpets and Interiors bid includes current tile removal and prep, commercial grade LVT, installation and new base molding for \$5,083.98. The Weekday Preschool will pay 50% of the cost. The remaining balance is \$2,541.99, and would come from our General Fund. This motion will be voted on July 6th at the end of service.
