Although part of the largest lay Catholic organization in the world, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul has only been operating across the Diocese of Richmond since 2016.

The Society has been operating in the US, since 1845. US membership totals nearly 90,000 in over 4,000 communities.

Starting with 10 Vincentians in two communities in the Diocese in 2016, we now stand at 320 Vincentians, across 9 Conferences in 2025.

Our goal remains the same - the spiritual development of our members through service to others regardless of creed, ethnic or social background, health, or gender.
