The enthusiast also owns exotics like the Porsche GT RS2, McLaren 720S, Rolls Royce Drop Head Coupe, Lamborghini Aventador SVH, Porsche GT RS3 and many more such exotics. Rolls Royce Phantom DHC The Rolls Royce Phantom DHC remains the most expensive convertible that money can buy in the world. There are only a few of them in India and Mayur Shree owns one with customised number plates that have his name on it. The white coloured Rolls Royce DHC is one of the vehicles that he uses regularly. But there are not many who own the convertible version of this car. Mayur Shree owns a yellow and black painted Aventador convertible and takes it out on the empty streets at night. A sure way to enjoying the wind in the hair. McLaren P1 The P1 from the British sports car manufacturer - McLaren is a limited production hybrid sports car. It is said to be the most complex road-going McLaren ever designed. Only 375 units of the P1 were ever produced. With the 3.8-litre petrol engine and hybrid system, the P1 generates a maximum power of 916 PS and it can reach the top speed of 350 km/h. Porsche GT3 RS It is a track car that can take on corners at extreme speed. The Porsche GT3 RS is one of the most advanced track tools that money can buy. It is a road-legal can and is a dream of many enthusiasts.



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It is a convertible with that gets powered by a massive V12 engine that produces a maximum of 715 PS. It can do 0-100 km/h in just 3.2 seconds and takes 6.7 seconds to reach 0-100 km/h. Lamborghini Urus This is the first-ever modern-day Lamborghini SUV and it has become one of the quickest selling models from the Italian brand ever. But there are many Indians who stay in foreign and own Bugatti Veyron. Based in the USA, Mayur Shree is the owner of the Chiron. The real-estate businessman Mayur Shree operates from Texas, USA. He bought the Chiron several years ago. While the exact price that customers pay to buy the Chiron is not known, the ballpark figure is around Rs 21 crore. The Chiron is the most expensive and most powerful car in his garage as well. It gets powered by an 8.0-litre quad-turbocharged W16 engine that generates a maximum power of 1,479 Bhp and a peak torque of 1,600 Nm. There are about 100 Bugatti Chirons around the world, making the model quite exotic and rare. Aston Martin DBS Superleggera This is one of the latest cars in his garage. The beautiful looking Aston Martin DBS Superleggera was gifted by his parents as a wedding present. It comes powered by a massive V12 engine that produces a maximum power of 715 PS. It can do 0-100 km/h in just 3.2 seconds and takes 6.7 seconds to come to a standstill from that speed. Lamborghini Urus This is the first-ever modern-day Lamborghini SUV and it has become one of the quickest selling models from the Italian brand ever. Resultant, Bugatti became one of the most exclusive and fastest car brands in the world. The Bugatti made its Indian debut in 2010 with Veyron. Seeing the exclusivity and huge price tag of 16 Cr ex-showroom (Mumbai), the supercar brand didn't receive a good response in sales. However, as discussed earlier, few speed lovers took interest and became Bugatti owners in India. So, without further ado, let's check the India Bugatti owners with images and prices. Mind you, there are only 100 Bugatti Chiron in the world, and it comes with a heavy price tag of about Rs 21 crores or \$3 million (without any customization). Mayur Shree standing with his father in front of Bugatti Chiron Supercar. The Chiron is the most expensive production Bugatti in the world. Currently, Mayur is the only Indian to own a Bugatti Chiron. Well, don't get confused, buying a Bugatti is not as easy as you might think. According to the process, Mayur provided his past car details as a resume and paid \$25,000 as a token fee to wait for 2 years for the delivery. Mayur Shree is a 32-years USA-based Indian real estate businessman. Except for Bugatti Chiron, he owns Rolls Royce DHC convertible, Lamborghini Aventador convertible, McLaren P1, Porsche GT3 RS, Aston Martin DBS Superleggera, Lamborghini Urus, Lamborghini Murcielago Roadster, and the list is growing. Dr. C.J. Roy is a founder and chairman of Confident Group, a real estate company working in pan India (Kerala, Bangalore, etc.), UAE, and USA. The \$1.3 million Bugatti Veyron owner owns over 200 luxury and supersport cars and still updating the collection. Sir J. R. D. Tata was known for starting and establishing several Tata industries such as TCS, Tata Motors, Titan, and many more. Indian govt. rewarded him with Bharat Ratna for his contribution to the economic growth of the country. J. R. D. Tata's driving his Bugatti Type 37. Except for entrepreneurship, J. R. D. Tata had a keen interest in cars, especially sports cars with good top speed and handling. In Feb 1926, R. D. Tata wired the collective money to J. R. D. Tata with a message "from Bombay buy Bugatti". It was a dream come true for Jehangir. Sir J. R. D. Tata bought a Bugatti Type 37, which later on shipped to India. Bugatti never sold any Veyron in India. There was only Veyron for road-testing and launch event. All Veyron owners bought their supercar outside India, such as Dubai, America, etc. No, Mukesh Ambani doesn't own any Bugatti model. However, he has a wide range of other super and luxury cars. Mayur Shree owns the only Bugatti Chiron model in India. The businessman purchased this expensive supersport for his father. Depending on the customization and other equipments, Bugatti Chiron costs between 19.2 to 21 crore in India. There are only 40 Bugatti Divo in the world. All of the units are selected for selected Bugatti Chiron owners. Currently, there are no Bugatti Divo owners in India. Bugatti has designed and manufactured only one Bugatti La Voiture Noire, which Cristiano Ronaldo has already bought. According to reports, Bugatti La Voiture Noire is the most expensive car in the world. No, Bugatti doesn't have any official showroom in India. Yes, there was a Bugatti Veyron in Mumbai for road testing and launch event.
