Amendment to Bylaws under Club constitution. Rule 64

Class of Membership (Rule 8)

Ordinary membership of person over 55 years of age.

Associate membership if under 55 years of age. Associate members have all the benefits of ordinary membership, except for voting rights at General Meetings and Annual General Meetings.

Honorary Membership for any active or non-active member who has considered to have made a major contribution to the structure, management or ethos of the Club. The criteria for appointment of honorary members shall be:

- The member to have shown leadership in the management and ethos of the Club.
- To have been a member for at least 10 years.
- To have held a Management Committee role for at least 5 years.

Honorary membership may be recommended by any member with a seconder, but must be supported by a 75% majority at an AGM.

Committee members (Rule 27 (2))

(2) In addition to the office bearers, there shall be four ordinary committee members, three appointed by voting at the Annual General Meeting, and one of which shall be the Walks Coordinator appointed under Rule 48.
