Ref No.	Pt to Pt	Cum.	Walk Details
1			Head east along Nanga Road
2	100m	100m	Turn right in to Trees Adventure center after creek.
3	100m	200m	Head past kiosk to track heading north east.
4	0.5km	0.7km	Turn right up hill on King Jarrah trail (green boot markers)
5	2.2km	2.9km	Cross track, KSO on King Jarrah trail.
6	1.3km	4.2km	Cross track (Coffs form) KSO
7	1.0km	5.2km	Cross track. KSO
8	1.1km	6.3km	Cross track (Dawn Creek Road) Turn left off King Jarrah trail.
9	1.4km	7.7km	T junction (King Jarrah Form) Turn right & pass gate.
10	0.3km	8.0	Turn right off King Jarrah Form on to single track at King Jarrah sign.
11	0.3km	8.3km	King Jarrah tree. Continue up hill.
12	1.6km	9.9km	Cross track (Dawn Creek Road) Turn left off King Jarrah trail.
13	0.9km	10.8km	Track joins from right. KSO
14	1.6km	12.4km	Nanga Road (bitumen) Turn right.
15	0.1km	12.5km	Veer right off Nanga Road on to forestry track. Waterous trail markers. (Orange yabby) Can follow these back to car park.
16	0.4km	12.9km	Track to left. KSO.
17	0.1km	13.0km	Track to left. KSO
18	0.2km	13.2km	Track to right. KSO
19	0.7km	13.9km	Track to left with gate. KSO
20	1.0km	14.9km	Track to right. KSO
21	1.0km	15.9km	T junction. Turn left.
22	0.1km	16.0km	Parking area.
