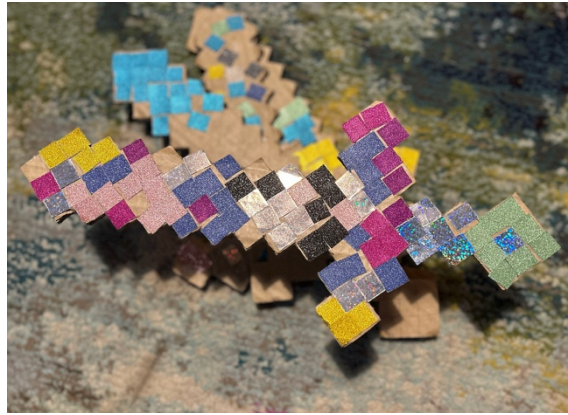


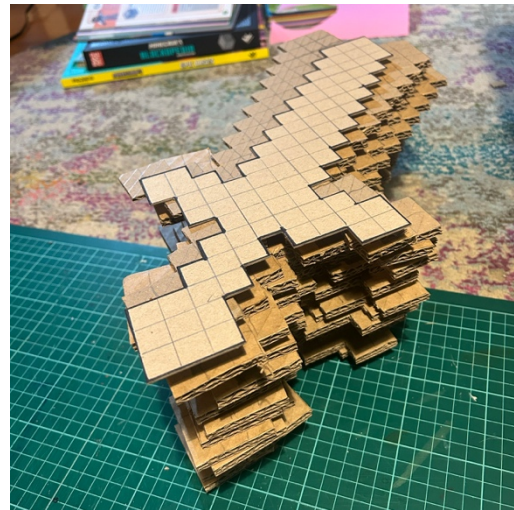
MINECRAFT PIXEL SWORDS



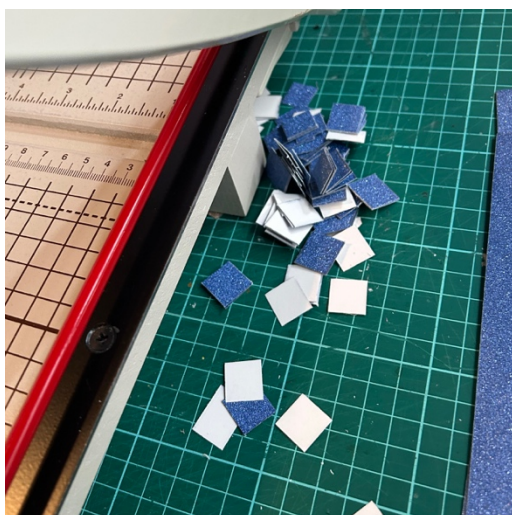
Print the template at full size with no adjustment to scale (A3).

I then used this to cut out one sword from corrugated craft board (I used 5mm thick). I used this as an “outline stencil” to draw the others.

I then drew the grid-lines for the children to stick the “pixels” on by hand, using the edge of the design as “guides”. You could use a ruler if you really wanted it to be perfect.



The “pixels” are 15mm x 15mm (aprox 0.6” x 0.6”) **I would suggest cutting the “pixels” to 0.5” x 0.5”** I used a guillotine to cut up strips and then squares of different coloured card (I used glitter card mainly).



I then had glue sticks for the children and let them go at their own pace to decorate as they wanted. It works best if then apply the glue to the sword and then arrange the pixels onto that rather than trying to glue each pixel individually.
