We will teach you the basic steps and formations and introduce you to some easy Scottish Country dances like the ones you may have seen or joined in with during an audience participation. Five (5) classes will be held on Monday evenings, 6:45pm to 8:00pm at Grace Anglican Church, 319 W. Sycamore St., Mount Washington, Pittsburgh, PA 15211; **April 24, May 1, 8, 15 and 22**. A graduation celebration will be held as part of our **June 10 AGM** dance, where a few of the dances will be beginner friendly. Make-up dates will be announced, should any class need to be postponed. Cost is \$35 for all classes, including the celebration, payable at the beginning of the first class (cash or check)

For your protection and for the protection of others, all participants must be fully vaccinated with an FDA approved Covid-19 vaccine. Boosters are encouraged. Proof of vaccination is required, along with a government issued photo ID. Bring with you to the first class. Those that do not have proof will not be able to attend. Masks are suggested but not required as long as the CDC Community Level in Allegheny County is Low. Hand sanitizer will be available.
