Leon&I is a wordless journey through the non-verbal universe that tells a story of emotions, failure and achievement.

We enter the absurd and dreamlike world of a curious lion Tamer: atypical, awkward and clumsy.

His authority scares no one at all! A huge curtain hides something, everything is ready and the proud Tamer presents his Leon but...where is he?

Thus begins an adventure in search of Leon, a ferocious rag puppet who has no intention of jumping into the ring of fire because he prefers to stay high and fly.

Between daring acrobatics in the air, trapeze tricks and circles of fire, we will follow Leon in his adventure: will he be able to fulfill his dream of being a circus trapeze artist?

A poetic story that entertains and makes you think: perhaps we are not destined to be what everyone expects of us... everyone has a dream in their heart and we can all make it come true!







#### THE CHARACTERS

**Leon** represents our childish part, the little one that is still inside each of us: he takes us into the world of lightness, where the pleasure of playing and the will to fly wins!


**The Tamer** is clumsy and rough, he trips over his own feet, he puts on a lot of airs but deep down he is very afraid of everything... he is the adult stripped of his authority who thus reveals all his fragility.

**The Trapeze Artist**, the Tamer's female alter ego, is sweet and a little careless, she loves climbing up high and lives for the audience's applause; she arrives on stage to convince Leon to finally come down and do his act...

Clowning is a language, it's a way of seeing the world that's similar to how a child perceives reality; wonder flows through them, as enthusiasm, curiosity and a craving for discovery drive their every action. Children always want to put their bodies to the test and it is through movement that they discover themselves. So, with the same naivety and sense of wonder, a Clown can tell the story of how they view the world, without judgment or malice, but with amazement and acceptance.




# **MAP OF AERIAL RIG**



The aerial structure is a certified freestanding rig. No floor anchoring is required. The rig can be assembled for different heights, in accordance with the available space.

## **TECHNICAL SHEET**

#### **SPACE**

- indoor or outdoor
- preferably with vehicle access (van or car)
- flat (grass, cement, wooden stage etc.) and suitable for the assembly of an aerial rig of the following dimensions:

5,10 m x 5,10 m height 6 m or 3,65 m x 3,65 m height 5 m or 2,77 m x 2,77 m height 3,60 m

#### **AUDIENCE LAYOUT**

This is an end-on show, with an audience arrayed at 180° in front of the aerial rig.

#### **ASSEMBLY AND DISASSEMBLY**

45 mins, including 15 mins in which 2 assistants are required for assembly and disassembly.

#### **SOUND AND LIGHTS**

- artist will provide own sound system
- light system to be provided by organisers and to be agreed upon before the show
- 2 lights

### **AUDIENCE**

from 0 to 10 years of age

#### **SHOW LENGTH**

45 mins
