MEASUREMENT OF HORSES

Horses will be measured between the hours of 3:00 – 8:00 p.m., Thursday April 23 and 8am Friday & Saturday morning. Other measurements will be **ALL HORSES** must be measured. Measurement cards per AMHA Rule GR-20.G, in lieu of measuring. Measurement card must be presented to measuring officials in the measurement area. **** If you can't measure within the set hours, please fill in the appropriate space on the entry blank as to when you would like to measure. If there is a problem with your time, we'll call you. HARDSHIP MEASUREMENTS WILL TAKE PLACE AT 8:00 am, SATURDAY 4/25/2026.**

General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2026 rules and regulations of the AMHA. All horses must be registered with the AMHA. This AMHA show has two judges. Points and awards will be awarded for each judge. Awards will be given to 1st - 6th place.

Stabling: Stalls are 10' x 10' with metal construction on clay floors. No more than 2 horses per stall. Stallions 2 & older must be stalled separately. **NO BEDDING IS INCLUDED WITH THE STALLS & NO OUTSIDE BEDDING MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE SHOW GROUNDS.** Shavings are available for \$13.00 for shavings or pellets. Please preorder on your entry form.

Showing off the trailer is permitted at a cost of \$50.00/horse per day. Please help keep the facility clean by putting trash in the barrels and manure in the dumpsters.

Early Arrivals: Exhibitors wishing to arrive before noon on Thursday 4/23 or layover on Sunday, 4/26 must make advance arrangements with Show Management & will be charged an extra **\$35 per stall per night.**

Camping: Full hookups with water and electric are \$45.00 per night. Payment is available on the entry forms.

Food Stand: A concession stand will be in operation Friday - Sunday during show hours.

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck, in the arena or in the horse show office.

Dogs: Dogs must be leashed or penned at all times and are NOT allowed in the concession area.

Paperwork Requirements & Health Regulations: Copies of registration papers must be included with entries. Entries submitted without papers will be held pending until all requirements are met. All In-state horses must have a current coggins – current within (1) year. Out-of-state horses need original negative coggins (within one year) & health certificate within 45 days.

Youth Classes: All youth must have an AMHA Youth number to be considered for National awards or titles. Youth card applications are available at the Horse Show Office.

Amateur An AMHA Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Applications are available in the Show Office.

Evaluation Forms: Judge evaluation forms will be available at the horse show office.

Liability Statement: Greater Houston Miniature Horse Club, its officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, driver, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at this show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY to this show or show grounds.

Show Policy: Evidence of any cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment to a horse, in or out of the ring, will not be tolerated by the Show Management and shall result in disqualification of the horse and that exhibitor for the balance of the show. The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. Show management will notify AMHA of any such disqualification when the show results are reported.

Pre-Entries: **Pre-Entries must be postmarked by April 8, 2026.**

Added Classes: **Added classes** will be accepted up to four classes preceding the class to be entered.

Refunds: The GHMHC will give a full refund if entries are cancelled with Show Manager by the April 8 (closing date). If entries are cancelled in writing to the show manager and accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate of inability to show after the pre-entry closing date, but before the official start of the show (8:30 a.m. Friday, April 24) all fees other than the stall and office fee will be refunded. After the official start of the show, there will be no refunds. **Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.**

Vendors: The fee for commercial exhibitors is \$100 for the weekend, without electricity, \$150 with electricity. Tables and chairs are not provided but can be rented from facility. Contact Show Management.

Class Sponsorships: The cost of sponsoring a regular class is \$10.00 and \$15.00 for a championship class. Sponsors will be acknowledged during the show and are welcomed to present the ribbons for their classes.

GHMHC will offer some non-AMHA rated classes for the Galaxy show that folks have been requesting. They are open to any miniature horse OR miniature donkey, registered or not, shown by any person. No measurement restrictions but must conform to breed standards. They will be held throughout the show and are indicated with ** and an Un-Registered before the class title. The entry fee for each class is \$15 per class. Questions??? call Nancy.

HIGHPOINT AWARDS

Each exhibitor must declare their intention to be included in the High Point competition by marking the appropriate space on the back of the entry blank or signing up at the Horse Show Office prior to the first class they are to show in. Points will be calculated from the combined points of both judges. Points will be awarded in inverse order of placing; 1st – 6 points; 2nd – 5 pts., 3rd – 4; 4th – 3; 5th – 2; 6th – 1, if there are 6 or more horses in a class. If there are less than 6 horses in a class, points will be based on that number of horses; ie; 3 horses in a class >>> 1st – 3 points; 2nd- 2; 3rd- 1.

Youth Highpoint – Grand & Reserve

Awarded to one youth/horse combination in each of three age groups (7 Years & under, 8 thru 12 Years & 13 thru 18 Years). A youth may be in more than one combination, using a different horse. Points will be calculated from Youth classes only.

High Point Amateur

An award will be made to the one amateur/horse combination that accumulates the highest number of points in amateur classes. AOTE classes do not count towards this highpoint. An amateur may compete in more than one amateur/horse combination.
