The AMHA horse show is sponsored by and sanctioned under the rules of the American Miniature Horse Association, Alvarado, Texas. ALL HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE AMHA TO COMPETE IN THE AMHA SHOW with the exception of the Un-Registered classes. Those horses need not be registered but must meet all of the health requirements and AMHA standards.

It is the exhibitors' responsibility to familiarize themselves with and to follow the rules as set forth in the official Rulebook of AMHA. The Show Manager reserves the right to settle all questions, differences and disputes arising out of or connected with or incident to the show within the boundaries of the current show rules, and to cancel or combine classes.

A COPY OF BOTH SIDES OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS OF EACH HORSE ENTERED MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SHOW MANAGER WITH EACH HORSE ENTRY AS WELL AS A COPY OF YOUR STALLION TESTICULAR REPORT FOR ANY AMHA SENIOR STALLION ENTERED. Entries that are received without a copy of both sides of the registration papers will be held pending until such papers are submitted. For geldings, gelding status must be reflected on the Certificate of Registration in order to show in any class. If you are showing a leased horse, please include a copy of lease with the AMHA stamp.

Youth and Amateur exhibitors **must provide a copy of their current AMHA Youth or Amateur card with their entries** and provide such #'s on the front side of the entry blank. Applications for both these numbers will be available at the Show Office. Please acquaint yourselves with current association rules concerning youth and amateurs.

This Show is qualified for AMHA Show points and Greater Houston Miniature Horse Club High Point Awards

NO LOGOS, NAMES OR OTHER IDENTIFICATION OF PERSON OR FARM WILL BE ALLOWED ON ANY EXHIBITOR, HORSE OR VEHICLE IN THE SHOW ARENA.

ENTRIES CLOSE: June 4, 2026

REGULAR ENTRIES JUNE 4th, 2026. A Post/Late entry fee will be charged for entries not postmarked by this date, of \$10 per horse. Post/Late entries will be accepted until 7:30 am June 14th and 15th, 2026. Additional class entries will be accepted up to four classes before the class you wish to show, except for classes with an order of go. Entries for any class with an order of go (ie; hunter, jumper, obstacle, liberty, etc.) must be made at least 10 classes in advance of the class to be shown in, or the entry will be placed 1st in the order of go.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

GSWEC requires the following >>>

Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by the following documentation:

Current Vaccines: Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) Vaccinations within six months prior to entering the show grounds.
Coggins Test: Texas State law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA Certificate dated within one year.

Health Certificate: A Health certificate dated within **21 days** of arrival to be presented when entering the show grounds.

These are Great Southwest Regulations and are not subject to debate. GHMHC has no control over them.

STALLS: \$80.00 EACH (arrival after Noon on Friday)

Stalls are box stalls (10x10) of wood or wood & metal construction. No more than 2 horses per stall.

Stalls will be available at Noon, Friday JUNE 12th and must be vacated by 9 p.m. Sunday, June 14th. Anyone wanting to arrive earlier or stay later must make advance arrangements with Show Management and additional fees will apply. **No bedding is included with stalls.** Shavings will be available on the Show Grounds for \$15.00 per bag (min. 1 bag per stall). Please order your shavings on the entry blank. **NO SHAVINGS MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE SHOW GROUNDS**

Horses may be brought for sale but must pay regular stall fees and meet health requirements. Stall decorations are encouraged.

MEASUREMENT OF HORSES

Horses will be measured between the hours of 3:00 – 8:00 p.m., Friday, JUNE 12th. **ALL HORSES** must be measured. Measurement cards per AMHA Rule GR-20.G, in lieu of measuring. Measurement card must be presented to measuring officials in the measurement area. **** If you can't measure within the set hours, please fill in the appropriate space on the entry blank as to when you would like to measure. If there is a problem with your time, we'll call you. HARDSHIP MEASUREMENTS WILL TAKE PLACE AT 8:00 am, SATURDAY 6/13/2026.**

AMHA JUDGE'S EVALUATION CARDS

Judge's Evaluation Cards are no longer mandatory but may be filled out on a voluntary basis. Cards are available at the Horse Show Office.

REFUND POLICY

The GREATER HOUSTON MINIATURE HORSE CLUB will give a full refund for a horse that has become ill, as long as a veterinarian's certificate of inability to show is provided for said horse, before the official start of the show June 13th, 2026 at 9:00 a.m.

Substitution of a horse will be accepted with no late fee.

CLASS SPONSORSHIPS

The cost of sponsoring a regular class is \$10.00. \$15.00 to sponsor a Grand or Supreme Champion Class. Sponsors will be acknowledged during the Show and are welcomed to present the ribbons for their classes.

COMMERCIAL EXHIBITORS

The fee for commercial exhibitors is \$35.00 per day for a small display, \$60.00/day for larger displays. Tables & chairs are not provided.

HEALTH REGULATIONS – please see 1st page of this premium book. This is a facility requirement. GHMHC does not have any control over them. You can email or mail a copy with your entries or bring to check in. Show packets will not be released until appropriate health papers are provided. The show must turn in copies of entries & health papers several times a day and if you come without what is required, they will call a vet to come out and get what is required at your expense.

Sorry....there is no wiggle room on this policy.

NEW!!! Un-Registered Classes

GHMHC will offer some non-AMHA rated classes for the Galaxy show that folks have been requesting. They are open to any miniature horse OR miniature donkey, registered or not, shown by any person. No measurement restrictions but must conform to breed standards. They will be held throughout the show and are indicated with ** and an Un-Registered before the class title. The entry fee for each class is \$15 per class. Questions??? call Nancy.

HIGHPOINT AWARDS

Each exhibitor must declare their intention to be included in the High Point competition by marking the appropriate space on the back of the entry blank or signing up at the Horse Show Office prior to the first class they are to show in. Points will be calculated from the combined points of both judges. Points will be awarded in inverse order of placing; 1st – 6 points; 2nd – 5 pts., 3rd – 4; 4th – 3; 5th – 2; 6th – 1, if there are 6 or more horses in a class. If there are less than 6 horses in a class, points will be based on that number of horses; ie; 3 horses in a class >>> 1st – 3 points; 2nd- 2; 3rd- 1.

Youth Highpoint – Grand & Reserve

Awarded to one youth/horse combination in each of three age groups (7 Years & under, 8 thru 12 Years & 13 thru 18 Years). A youth may be in more than one combination, using a different horse. Points will be calculated from Youth classes only.

High Point Amateur

An award will be made to the one amateur/horse combination that accumulates the highest number of points in amateur classes. AOTE classes do not count towards this highpoint. An amateur may compete in more than one amateur/horse combination.
