- Do not leave notes on your door stating you are not at home.

Clyde Thomas House

This house, located at 50325 Cherry Hill Road, was supposedly built in 1845 by Thomas Clyde, son of Canton pioneers Eliza Huston and Hugh R. Clyde, a grandson of Canton pioneers William and Mary Huston. In 1858, it was owned by John Huston II, a farmer, who was active in township government. This large family was influential in the political, architectural, and agricultural development of the township. Built in the upright and double-wing form of the Greek revival style, this house is significant architecturally, as well as an excellent preserved example of this popular form and style. HOMEMADE EGGNOGG

Ingredients:

- 6 large egg yolks
 - 3/4 cup sugar
- 2 cups milk
- 2 whole cloves
- Pinch cinnamon
 - 1 cup heavy cream
- 1 teaspoon freshly grated nutmeg (lightly packed)
- ♦ 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 tablespoons bourbon and rum, or to taste

Directions:

In a large bowl, use a whisk or electric mixer to beat egg yolks until they become somewhat lighter in color. Slowly add sugar, beating after each addition. Beat at high speed or whisk until fluffy. Combine milk, cloves and cinnamon in a thick-bottomed saucepan. Slowly heat on medium heat until milk mixture is steamy hot, but not boiling. Add the eggs by slowly adding half of the hot milk mixture into the eggs, whisking constantly while you add the hot mixture. Pour the mixture back into the saucepan. Cook the eggnog on medium heat, stirring constantly with a wooden spoon, until the mixture begins to thicken slightly and coats the back of the spoon. Do not allow the mixture to boil. Remove from heat and stir in the cream. Strain the mixture through a mesh strainer to remove cloves and any curdled bits. Chill for 1 hour. Stir in vanilla extract, nutmeg and bourbon and rum (omit for kid-friendly eggnog and proceed to chill). Enjoy!!! (©2025 SimpleRecipes.com. All rights reserved.)

You want the website address to start with https://. Not Every Ad on Your Social Feed Is Real! Make sure to check the brand's official profile and look for a verified checkmark.
