**History of Canton Township — 1825:** On October 26, the Erie Canal was opened, connecting the Atlantic Ocean to the Great Lakes. Settlers from New England began landing in Canton, where the Potawatomi tribe was already settled. **1834:** On March 7, Canton officially became a Michigan Township. Before this, Canton was referred to as “South Plymouth.” **1874:** Township Hall, Canton’s first government office, was built at Canton Center and Cherry Hill, costing \$700 to build. Summer is just around the corner, and the Board wants to share with you some maintenance tips:

- \* Take a walk around your house to inspect your gutters, downspouts and roof to make sure there was no damage through the winter.
- \* Make sure your downspouts are clean.
- \* Check the caulk on your windows to make sure there is no cracking from the winter.
- \* This is a good time to prune your trees. As a reminder, your trees need a 7' clearance from the street.
- \* Freezing and thawing is tough on concrete. Inspect your driveway for cracks.
- \* Check your sprinkler systems before turning on for the season.
- \* Inspect your air conditioner to make sure it is ready for the summer.
- \* Check the trees at your curb to see if they need to be replaced.
- \* Weed around your landscaping and your driveway, and pull suckers around your street trees.

### PENNE WITH SMOKED SAUSAGE

#### Ingredients:

- ◆ 1 Tbsp. olive oil
- ◆ 1 lb. smoked sausage
- ◆ 1/2 cup diced onion
- ◆ 1 Tbsp. minced garlic
- ◆ 1/2 tsp. salt
- ◆ 1/2 tsp. pepper
- ◆ 2 cups chicken broth
- ◆ 1 (10 oz.) can diced tomatoes
- ◆ 1/2 cup milk

- ◆ 2 cups dry penne pasta
- ◆ Crushed red pepper, shredded Parmesan cheese, Basil leaves & Arugula leaves

#### Directions:

- ◆ Heat olive oil in a large pan over medium heat.
- ◆ Slice sausage into bite-sized pieces.
- ◆ Brown onion and sausage in olive oil.
- ◆ Add garlic, salt and pepper.
- ◆ Continue cooking for about 30 seconds.
- ◆ Add chicken broth, tomatoes, milk and dry pasta to the pan and bring to a boil.
- ◆ Reduce heat to low and cover.
- ◆ Simmer for 15 minutes.
- ◆ Remove from heat and top with crushed red pepper and Parmesan cheese.
- ◆ Garnish with Basil and Arugula leaves. Enjoy!

### QUICK HOME FIX IT TIPS

#### **UNEVEN SHOWER STREAM**



Behind a shower's handle is a valve responsible for correctly mixing hot and cold water and keeping the pressure consistent. If your shower struggles with either of those tasks, install a replacement pressure balance cartridge for about \$30:

Shut off the water to the shower. Remove the screws holding the handle and trim plate, then the screws holding the valve cap. Use pliers to pull out the old cartridge; slide the
