

Good Afternoon Everyone,

I wanted to give you a quick update on the contractor's (Audia) progress. They are ahead of schedule and will be in your sub cutting concrete in the next few weeks. You have probably seen pavement markings in Central Park 2 and River Woods already. Saw cutting will start as early as later this week starting in Central Park 2. I don't anticipate removals to start until mid-August. Once we are close to starting removals, we will pass out door hanger notifications to residents who will directly be affected by the concrete removal and replacement, giving them instructions. Also, our Inspector Tony will knock on doors and talk to whoever is home at the time he drops them off.

Please remind residents to drive slowly through concrete slurry created by the wet saw that cuts the concrete. Also, if any sprinklers are damaged by either the saw cutting or the concrete removals, please let me or Tony know so Audia can fix them. It does happen due to the sprinklers being installed so close to the curb.

We are having issues in other subs with kids riding bikes through, and people walking through freshly poured concrete. Please let the residents know to walk around new concrete areas that have cones around them, at least for a few hours after it's been poured. Also, tell residents not to move cones and drive on concrete that has not cured long enough to allow vehicles on it. This is also happening in other subs. If the concrete cracks from the vehicles, it will not be the contractor's nor the Township's responsibility to replace the concrete.

Updates will be provided as we get closer to construction.
