Waste Hauling Contract

- **Current contract expires July 31, 2024.**
- **RFP issued in September 2023**
- **Three proposals received:**
 - Priority Waste
 - GFL
 - Titan Environmental Solutions





New 95-Gallon Carts

- **Priority Waste will begin collecting July 29.**
- **Collection day will NOT change.**
- **New carts will be delivered in early July.**
 - DO NOT use cart before July 29.
- **95-gallon Cart dimensions:**
 - 33.5" Deep
 - 28" Wide
 - 44.25" High
 - Same footprint as a 32 gallon trash can.
 - ADA Compliant





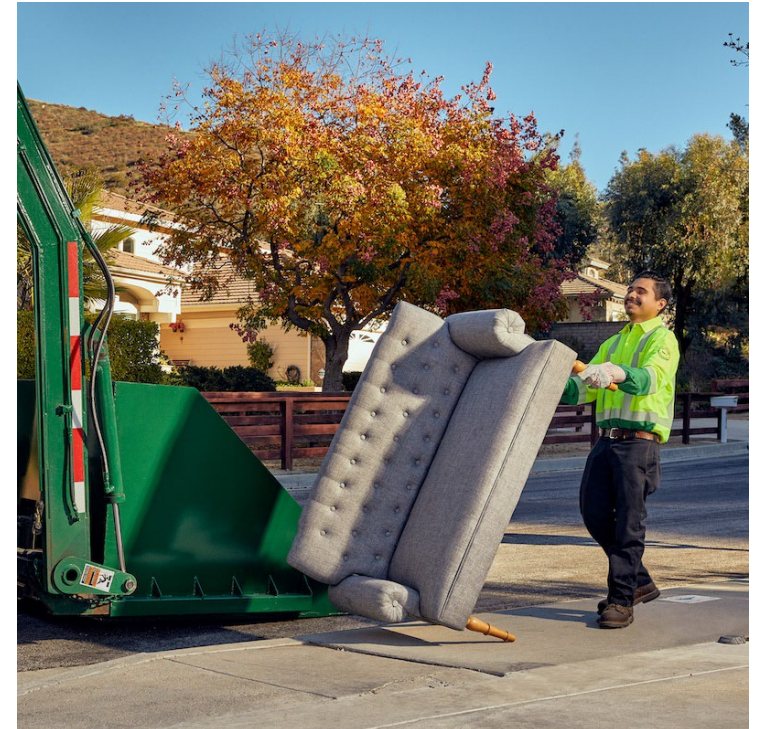
Collection Guidelines

- **Beginning July 29, all garbage MUST be placed inside the 95-gallon cart.**
 - Anything left outside the cart will not be collected.
- **Carts broken or damaged during service:**
 - Carts are under warranty by Priority Waste and will be replaced at no cost, as long as homeowner negligence is not identified.
- **Parking restrictions:**
 - Residents must leave at least three feet around the carts in order for the mechanical arm to fit around the cart.



Bulk Item Pickup

- **Priority Waste allows two large items per week, no special arrangements required.**
 - Refrigerators and freezers must have all Freon and doors removed in order to be collected.
 - 12 rolls of carpeting counts as large items.
 - E-waste only accepted at Canton Cleanups.





Recycling and Yard Waste

- **There will be no change to the curbside collection of recycling and yard waste.**
 - Recycling carts provided by GFL will now be the property of Canton Township.
 - Yard waste guidelines remain the same, no containers over 50lbs or over 32 gallons in size.





65-Gallon Cart Option

- **65-gallon carts will be available for a fee.**
 - Fee TBD
 - Must show proof of need (i.e. handicap sticker or vehicle tag)
 - MSD Admin will meet with HOA board members to determine if complex qualifies for smaller carts due to limited storage space.
- **Why do I need to pay a fee for a smaller cart?**
 - Contract is based on the purchase and delivery of 95-gallon carts. In order to accommodate residents with physical and/or storage challenges, Canton will need to purchase 65-gallon carts.



Canton Cleanups

- **Priority Waste will continue to provide residents with scheduled Canton Clean-up days.**
 - New location: Van Buren Transfer Station, 44135 Yost Road.
 - Visit cantonmi.gov/917 for 2024 Canton Cleanup Schedule.



During Canton Clean-up (held on selected Saturdays from 8am - 4pm) residents are limited to **ONE TRIP PER HOUSEHOLD**. PLEASE NOTE: Residents are responsible for unloading their own items and placing them in the dumpster. GFL employees will not be able to assist.

GFL **WILL** accept the following materials :

- Home electronics
- Motor Oil (limited to five, 1 gallon containers)
- Latex Paint (limited to five, 1 gallon containers - no limit on empty paint cans with the lid removed and paint dried out, only accepted on clean-up days)
- Clean Antifreeze (limited to five, 1 gallon containers)
- Household and Car Batteries
- Household Construction Debris
- Household Trash
- All Single Stream Recycling Materials (to obtain a list visit www.canton-mi.org)
- Sod and Tree Branches
- Metal
- Aluminum
- Copper
- Dirt
- Brick
- Concrete
- Yard Waste (April - December)

GFL will **NOT** accept the following:

- Commercial Vehicles of Any Kind
- Dual Wheeled Vehicles
- More than One Axle Trailers
- Hazardous Waste
- Oil Based Stain or Paint
- More than three cubic yards of trash (equal to about one level 6ft pick-up truck bed)
