IMPORTANT: *We Need to Change our Subdivision "Rules"*

As you may know, everyone who buys a home in the Riverwoods Sub has to follow the Covenants and Restrictions (C&Rs) that the developer recorded in 1997 with the Wayne County Register of Deeds.

Legally, the C&Rs are actually part of the deed to your property. Unfortunately, what the developers used for the C&Rs was a "one size fits all" document that was not tailored to the needs of our subdivision.

The Board has since identified nine items that need to be changed, but to do so requires the signature of 74 homeowners.

In the next few issues of the neighborhood Newsletter, we will be highlighting some of these needed changes.

More importantly, the C&R amendments will be available for everyone to sign at our 2019 annual meeting. Watch for details about that in our next newsletter!

HOA Meetings - Meetings are held every second Wednesday of the month, unless otherwise announced. A sign is posted on the Marquee at the front entrance of the subdivision. Meetings are held in the Administration Bldg. next to the Canton Public Library located at Canton Center and Civic Center.

HOA Dues 2019 - Due January 1, 2019. Dues are \$300.00. There is no change from 2018.

REMINDERS

With early snowfall arriving, we would like to remind everyone that we will do everything we can to ensure that the exit out of the subdivision is salted. However, we do not salt the intersections or the entranceway. Therefore, some areas may become slippery. So, please be careful when driving in the subdivision and give yourself plenty of time to stop.

SAFETY TIPS FOR HOLIDAY SHOPPERS

Police officials encourage shoppers to be aware of their surroundings and belongings at all times. This will decrease the odds of becoming a victim of theft. Canton police will increase patrols at local shopping centers between Thanksgiving and December 24 to help deter criminal activity as well.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO OUR SUBDIVISION RULES

AMENDED DECLARATION OF COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS - RIVERWOODS SUBDIVISION

- 2.) ARTICLE VI, SECTION 5: Allows non-compliant decks if built before 2002.
- 3.) ARTICLE VI, SECTION 8: Allows non-compliant fences/walls if built before 2002.
- 7.) ARTICLE VI, SECTION 19: Allows shielded A/C units in side yard.

Proposed changes 2, 3 and 7 (regarding pre-2002 decks, walls/fences, and A/C units) are necessary because the developers who wrote the rules then approved multiple violations of those rules. For example, the rules say that homeowners can't have any kind of wall in their back yard, or decks with anything overhead, or air conditioning units on the side of the house, and yet all of these were approved in our sub. The Board believes that it is unfair to require homeowners to remove or change items that were approved by the developers, especially now many years later. So, we are proposing to amend the C&Rs to grandfather in anything that was approved and in place in 2002 when the homeowners took over the subdivision from the developers.

SOFT CHRISTMAS COOKIES

Ingredients:

- 3 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup margarine, softened
- 1 1/2 cups white sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

Directions:

Sift flour, baking powder and salt together; set aside. In a large bowl, cream together the margarine and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in the eggs one at a time, then stir in the vanilla. Gradually blend in the sifted ingredients until fully absorbed. Cover dough, and chill for 2 hours. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C). Grease cookie sheets. On a clean floured surface, roll out small portions of chilled dough to 1/4 inch thickness. Cut out shapes using cookie cutters. Bake 6 to 8 minutes in the preheated oven or until edges are barely brown. Remove from cookie sheets to cool on wire racks. (©2018 All-recipes.com. All Rights Reserved.)



CHRISTMAS HEALTH TIP

Tis the season of tasty foods. The average person puts on a pound during the holidays. You can enjoy yourself and make good choices, however, if you know which items are naughty and which items are nice:

Naughty: Turkey Skin

The skin of turkey and chicken is loaded with saturated fat. Per gram, all fats are higher in calories than protein or carbs and bad fats raise cholesterol. Dark meat has more fat per bite than white meat.

Nice: Serve yourself turkey breast or other white meat without the skin.

Naughty: Stuffing

Stuffing is typically loaded with butter and high-fat meats, such as sausage. A single scoop may have up to 550 calories.

Nice: Replace butter with low-sodium chicken broth, and skip pork sausage in favor of a low-fat chicken, oyster or fruit alternative. Or try making wild rice stuffing instead.

Naughty: Buttery Mashed Potatoes

Usually, a lot of milk, butter and salt go into this classic comfort food. A cup of homemade mashed potatoes made with whole milk and butter can have 237 calories.

Nice: Mash the potatoes with low-fat milk or low sodium, fat-free chicken stock and skip the butter or salt. (©2018 WebMD, LLC. All rights reserved.)
