**HOTEL** La Quinta Inn & Suites by Wyndham Islip - MacArthur, 10 Aero Rd Bohemia NY 11716 telephone 631-881-7700 press 5, booking code is "Crazy Pants Cat Club." Rate is \$105.00 per night plus tax, no pet fee, but a \$100 hold will be placed on your credit card at check-in and removed after room inspection post-checkout. Block expires 2/14/2025. **IMPORTANT NOTE** Rooms booked online are not eligible for the show rate and may be charged a pet fee. CPCC has elected to use the TICA Hotel Room Inspection Procedures for exhibitors who lodge at this La Quinta using the club's group booking. Entry in this show, and lodging at this La Quinta using the club's group booking, shall constitute an acknowledgment by and consent of the exhibitor to these procedures.

**SHOW HOURS** Check-in: 7:30 - 8:30 AM Saturday. Use the back door entry and park in designated parking areas. Show begins at 8:45 AM BOTH Saturday and Sunday and runs through 5 PM. Please plan to remain in the show hall during advertised hours as we anticipate many visitors/spectators. Show Rule 212.7 All cats shall be presented for final awards during advertised show hours unless special permission to leave is granted by Show Management.

**ENTRY FEES** This show is using TOES, please enter on-line and forward full payment (US funds) within 24 hours. By entering the show, you agree to pay all fees whether you attend the show or not. Please note your payment obligation when submitting your entry form. Regardless of the date of entry, ALL fees must be received no later than the closing date of 2/25/24. Send PayPal payments to [crazypantscc22@gmail.com](mailto:crazypantscc22@gmail.com) and be sure to specify "Friends and Family!" **Sorry, no checks accepted.** No cash accepted at check-in unless approved in advance by show management and will incur an extra charge of \$25. Per TICA Show Rules, the Show Committee may, at its discretion, refuse to accept any entry for reasons specified in Show Rules 23.6.1 through 23.6.7.1. CPCC will pursue any debt owed to us to the extent of TICA show rules and NY law. See back page for full list of early bird, regular, and "Tardy Turtle" entry rates.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS** This is a non-vetted show. Any cat showing signs of illness, parasites, or fungus will be escorted from the show hall, with any cats owned, housed or agented by the same exhibitor. All entries should be vaccinated against feline viral rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, and feline enteritis, and should test negative for feline leukemia and feline AIDS. Cats or kittens from a house or cattery where there has been fungus or any infectious or contagious illness within 21 days of the opening date of the show are ineligible for entry and/or exhibition. Pregnant or lactating casts will be disqualified. New York law requires any animal over 4 months to be vaccinated against rabies (be prepared to show proof)! TICA show rules require all claws, front and back, to be clipped before benching.



**BENCHING & SUPPLIES** Double wire cages (22" x 22" x 44") available upon request. We must know the exact number of personal cages to set up the benching area properly. A single cage space (22" x 22") is provided for each cat entered. Two (2) kittens or one (1) cat are permitted in a single cage. No kitten under 3 months of age will be allowed in the show hall (be prepared to show proof of age.) If you are bringing your own cage, even if only a single-width cage, you must purchase the extra 1/2 (double) cage space. A grooming space is the same size as a double cage space: 22" x 44". All cages must be covered on the top, sides, back, and bottom. **IMPORTANT; Bring your own litter and boxes!** We will have only a limited amount of litter and disposable boxes as a courtesy to fly-in exhibitors. We will honor benching requests to the best of our ability. Only one benching request per exhibitor. Agent requests take priority over benching requests. Clerks will be benched first.

**CLERKS AND STEWARDS** Both are needed, please contact entry clerk if interested. Clerks will be paid \$60/day, provided lunch, and when possible, requests for specific judges will be honored and preferential benching provided. Licensed TICA Clerks will be given preference. Trainees/assistants are welcome. Do NOT deduct the clerk fee from your entry! Stewards will be paid \$25.00 per ring + free lunch.

**OTHER REQUIREMENTS** No Kitten, Cat, or Alter may be entered with a "registration pending" unless accompanied by documentation showing the cat is eligible for registration in TICA. TOES will prompt you for this documentation. No vending from the benching area! Sales cages are for exhibitors ONLY and must be owned by the same/paid exhibitor. Kittens must be three (3) calendar months of age. Proof of age must be provided on request. No kittens or cats may be confined to carriers during show hours. Any person disregarding these rules will be asked to leave the show. Project Meow takes no responsibility for your failure to familiarize yourself with applicable NY livestock and personal pet statutes. All kittens entered for competition must be at least four (4) and not more than eight (8) calendar months old on the day of the show. Kittens may be spayed or neutered. Household pets over 8 months of age MUST be spayed or neutered. Not sure of your cat's proper division or color? Declawed Household Pets are allowed. TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. By entering all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and show committee. Official show rules, registration information, and forms may be obtained from TICA, P.O. Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551, or online at <http://www.tica.org>. **Liability/Show Rules 2011.2:** The show management shall take all reasonable care of cats, carriers, and other personal property of exhibitors, but it is expressly stipulated that neither the show management nor any member of the club nor the club sponsoring the show can be held pecuniarily liable for the loss of or accident to the cats, carriers or other personal property of any exhibitor.
