Dear Readers,







Through various programs, mentorship, and activities, we aim to guide them toward spiritual maturity and personal growth.

Wins & Praises

We celebrate the many blessings and victories God has provided this year. One significant highlight the generous donation of sport shoes

for all our youth members last Chinese New

Year. This provision greatly benefited our youths and served as a timely blessing, encouraging them in their sports and recreational activities.

We also witnessed God's hand at work in the lives of our youths through the SailAbility Program, where six of our youths participated in sailing classes, with two of them having the incredible opportunity to represent Nepal in an international competition in Hong Kong. This experience not only developed their skills but also instilled confidence, resilience, and a sense of achievement.



Youth Ministry

The increase in youth participation across various programs has been encouraging, since late September, we welcomed 12 new youths into our ministry, most of whom transitioned from our Children Ministry "Kids Club". This marks an essential step in their faith journey as they integrate into the Youth Ministry, and it has been a joy to see them actively participating and growing in the community.

In addition, many of our youths benefited from After-School Tutoring, thanks to our dedicated team of volunteers. Before the tutoring program, 40% of students were failing math with an average score of 20-30%. After participating, there has been an improvement in their grades. A special shoutout goes to our dedicated volunteers for their commitment to mentoring, guiding, and investing in the next generation.

Pamila Rai – My journey at ICM

Hello everyone, my name is Pamila Rai and I've been coming to ICM since I was a small kid. ICM has taught me about the power of God's love, His character, and His forgiveness, which are essential to understanding what it truly means to be a Christian.

Since joining the Youths fellowship, worship has been my favourite part. It feels like I am in God's presence when my friends and I worship together, allowing me to feel closer to God.

In May 2023, I arrived in Hong Kong and began a journey filled with challenges and growth. After a series of training sessions, I transitioned into the F&B sector. However, I struggled to find inner peace and joy, feeling distanced from God due to my inability to attend Sunday services. Being new to this environment made integration difficult, and despite my desire to serve, I felt lost within a large community with only a few friends.

After six months, I learned about the Inner City Ministries (ICM) through family and friends and was inspired by their impact on our Ethnic Minority communities. I joined the ICM Sewing Ministry and Martin's Theology Class on Fridays. It was in Martin's class that I felt God's presence through *Psalm 46:10: "Be still and know that I am God."*

In November 2023, I was honoured to become the Director of Young Adult Fellowship. My role involved loving the youth in our community, encouraging them in their relationships with God and each other, leading the Discipleship Training School (DTS) every summer, and supporting other ministry leaders within ICM.

I set several goals for the past year: to integrate into the community, connect with backslidden believers from Nepali churches, and enhance my skills to fulfil my responsibilities. To achieve these, I met with various church leaders, volunteered in organizations to meet new young

adults, and attended training programs.

As summer approached, I felt overwhelmed by the Mini DTS theme: "A Time to Be Renewed." The investment of time, energy, and finances weighed heavily on me, and I questioned my ability to manage the program. Despite the support from my colleagues, I often felt lost and confused.

A few days later, I encountered a former school friend who was also a student in the program. She was struggling to know Christ better. This encounter reaffirmed that I was in the right place, fulfilling God's purpose. After the Mini DTS, she gave her life to Christ, and I had the joy of witnessing her baptism. Additionally, two brothers from Operation Dawn Island were baptized. The program fostered connections, and many students stayed in touch, bringing me joy and fulfilment.



After the summer, I began to build new friendships, including one with a friend who was facing personal challenges. By supporting her through difficult times and hospital appointments, I helped her reconnect with her faith. Gradually, she opened about her past, and her gratitude for my companionship was heartwarming.

While I thrived in my role, I recognized the need for personal growth. My background in serving the Lord for over seven years in Nepal helped me connect with Nepali churches in Hong Kong, enhancing my understanding of EM families and my responsibilities.

I also had to address family issues. With my mother-in-law, I built a prayer altar, and during an interview with Mr. Douglas Wallace (Chairman of the board), I reflected on my relationship with my father. His words prompted me to seek forgiveness, leading to a restored relationship.

I am thankful to ED Emmanuel for encouraging me to serve in ministry beyond church settings, and to my coworkers for their support and patience as I learned necessary skills.

As we move into 2025, my team and I remain dedicated to our mission: to bring hope to our community through learning opportunities, support for positive life choices, and encouragement through Christian discipleship. This past year, I encountered many young adults who had drifted away from the church. For 2025, I aim to:

- Reach out to new young adults
- Organize programs that lead them closer to God
- Upgrade my skills
- Engage in more volunteering activities

As I embark on this new year, I commit to pursuing my goals with intention and faith in our Lord Jesus. I believe my ministry can significantly impact the lives of young adults. By focusing on quality time with God and supporting my teammates, I trust that even amid challenges, God will continue to work wonders through us, extending His Kingdom and transforming lives.

classes in 2018. Unfortunately, the COVID-19 pandemic disrupted our classes, but when things calmed down, I was thrilled to return.

Ms Nanda welcomed us back warmly, ensuring everyone rejoined. Under Ms. Jenny's supervision, we embarked on many new projects, and I was delighted to invite friends interested in sewing. While the changes in my life may seem subtle to others, I know I have grown significantly. I can now alter items around my home, refresh my old clothes, and assist my friends with their sewing needs.

My time with Caroline Sister has deepened my relationship with God and helped me rebuild my family's spiritual foundation. I have regained my confidence and can now communicate more freely and tackle life's challenges. I love attending classes regularly; even learning one new pattern feels like a major accomplishment. I am grateful for the sewing machines, workspace, and materials provided to us.

dedication, humility, and calmness. I also appreciate Caroline Sister
for guiding us on the righteous path and teaching us to trust in our
Almighty God. I look forward to the exciting projects ahead!

Our ICM Christmas party and other family programs bring joy to everyone involved. Additionally, 56 people participated in the ICM Cantonese class and received medals for their achievements.

This year, we have set the following goals:

- Introduce new sample pieces and learn to sew with different kinds of fabric
- Reach out to new non-Christian women
- Organize activities like picnics and family outings to build closer relationships among the women



Family and Women's Ministry

As I look back in past 2024, I thank God for His grace in all situations. His presence as Jesus is same yesterday, today and forever. I'm serving among the families, mothers and women. I accompany



them to hospitals, immigration department; find schools for children and also spiritual counselling to the families. I thank God for His help in all circumstances and also guide them to trust God and pray in any situations.

We also pray and share at Moms in prayers fellowship every Fridays. There we pray for our children and their schools, teachers and their friends. They will also learn how we can pray proclaiming word of God.

It is my joy to share gospel whether accompany them to hospitals or they come to ICM. Many have accepted the Lord and then I introduce them to a church nearby their place and some are continually going to church. E.G, one brother name Krishna is going to one Nepali church.



Bible message sharing is also a part in ladies sewing class. One sister her name is Sakhila she use to bring two kids to our kid's class. One day she asked me to pray for her son who have some speech delay until 4 years old. So she had burden and love for this child. Though



she is not Christian, she asked me to pray for him. She told me after a few days he improved his talking. She felt this is a miracle of God Jesus. Now, he comes to Kids club and his sister too. Sakhila also believed and accepted Jesus as saviour. She feels like home in ICM. Now she has joined MIP, sewing class. She thanks God for giving her an opportunity to learn sewing, MIP and also participating in Nepali Dance during Christmas. She said God fulfilled her desire.

One sister her name is Shyama, she use to bring her son Pravin to ICM kids club in Chungking Mansions. Few years back she and her family moved to UK. Later she and her husband got baptized. Few months back she called me and asked me to share gospel with her son who is 25 now. He accepted Jesus and got baptized in UK. Last month I had an opportunity to visit my friends in UK. I met many families. Some have accepted Jesus in ICM. I also had a chance to share messages in different churches as our previous sisters from ICM are active in their churches. They cook food and invited non-Christian friend and asked me to share the Gospel. There were



around 10 People who accepted Jesus. Praise to our Lord Jesus that whatever they learned from ICM, now they are discipling others in UK. It was my joy to serve alongside these friends from ICM in their churches. I encouraged them to serve the Lord wherever they are placed by God. God brought them to join in the church and help the local church and gather those far away from the Lord. They were encouraged by my visit. They started to have home fellowship group in the church as a result.


Future goal is to do

- Obey and recognize God's voice and rebuild the body of Christ




Your Financial Gifts Are Vital To Our Mission
