As summer comes to a close, the pandemic continues to grip the city of Hong Kong, forcing staff to consider what it means to lead online or hybrid our programs into the fall of 2020.

While most of us acknowledge the state of disruption in terms of evangelism and outreach, but Inner City Ministries sees this moment as an opportunity to live out their faith by loving their neighbors and their communities. The outbreak of Covid-19 has had a material impact on Hong Kong, especially on vulnerable and marginalized groups in our community.

We have been praying and seeking God's wisdom. Despite of all the crisis, Inner City Ministry has taken some vital steps to continue His mission.



OUR RESPONSE TO COVID-19

Due to COVID-19 50% of the community have found themselves out of work and kids are stuck in their small apartments for long periods of time, families are struggling to pay their rent and young people are struggling with depression and/or other mental health issues. Due to the international travel restriction, some key family members got stuck in their home country causing the main income source to be completely cut off. ICM has observed all this and been actively taking part in providing support to the community we serve. Here are some of the ways we have been assisting our community:

- Over 100,000 face masks and 50,000 hand sanitisers distributed to street cleaners, elderly and family members.
- Over 50,000 kid's masks distributed to our kids.
- Due to living conditions many children find playing on mobile devices the only way to pass the time. ICM was able to provide them with some games that they encourage interactions and family time.
- With the help of our supporters we provided Wellcome/ParkNShop vouchers to our community. These enabled them to buy groceries for 15–20 days.
- Over 20 people found jobs through our International churches connections.
- Our staff helped many individual family members and kids with attending appointments at hospitals or private clinics while key family members are stuck in their home country.
- We provided one-on-one counselling to over 60 people struggling with depression and drugs during the lockdown in order to provide fellowship and encouragement.
- We continued to provide home-made Nepali food to the street cleaners in the community.



MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT

Due to COVID-19 the city has been in lock down on and off but even during those times we have continued our youth and teen's fellowship through Zoom. We have been able to engage others through our community care ministry more than ever by reaching out to the community in need. During this time we have been able to share the love of God through His Gospel. We have also been visiting drug addicts under the fly-overs and following up with the brothers who recently finish their drug rehabilitation by providing counselling. We received this testimony from one of those we ministered to:

Hi!

my name is Gurung Depen, I am 21 years old. During my teenage years I went out of track chasing worldly things which are temporary just to satisfy my inner soul. During this time I got involved in criminal activities and drug addiction. Admiring worldly and other bad things didn't end well but I went to Operation Dawn rehabilitation centre for 1 year treatment where I got to know more about God. I then volunteered there for 7 months where many church members and organisations would often visit to encourage us and share the word of God. During one visit I met the ICM team got a chance to know about ICM and youth members who were similar to my age. When I came back to the society I really struggled to start a new life but thank God, i went to ICM where i really felt blessed and encouraged while learning new things about Jesus and meeting more brothers and sister in Christ. ICM has been a real life saving platform for me. I am very thankful to God and ICM for this good opportunity to know more about God every week..



Thank you

- Over 100 people have heard the Gospel during the time of this Pandemic.
- 22 people accepted Jesus as their personal saviour since January 2020
- We sent two brothers to the rehabilitation centre.
- More than 200 kids have received school bags, school stationary gift packs, story books, card games and board games.
- Over 50 people received free eye checkup in co-operation with Eye Care Charitable Foundation.
