SEWING MINISTRY

Our sewing ministry commenced in February 2012, and since that time 500 people have attended with 80% of attendees being from the community. Some have joined as a result of their connection with parents through our Saturday kid's club or other programs, but primarily members are invited to join by those attending the group. The Sewing Group is very welcoming and family oriented. Some come just to explore and listen to the word of God while others knit. Some are very skilled while others come to learn from other members of the group.



Jaimashi everyone,

I Nanda am extremely happy to be a part of the ICM (Inner City Ministry) family. I am grateful for the ICM family because they also accepted me just the way I am.

Before joining ICM I had very little knowledge about managing a kitchen, family as well as many other aspects of my life. In fact, sewing was never part of my life, but by the grace of God, ICM has opened the door for me to learn so that I am now able to teach other ladies. Still, I am learning and teaching at the same time with the great help from our beloved Jenny Didi who is always there ready to teach me patiently, even though I make many mistakes in the sewing process.

In the year 2022-2023 we have 25 women who have participated in the sewing ministry. There are fifteen in the junior and ten women in the senior group who have registered. Due to various reasons one or two women were unable to join the sewing ministry. Though sewing seems small when we hear about it, it has brought a huge impact on women who have taken part in the sewing ministry. As they testify that before they didn't even know how to mend tattered clothes with a needle but after coming to ICM for sewing, now they feel easy to carry small stuff in their own house, for example, to make an apron, stitch bed sheets, pillow covers, baby clothes, curtains, pencil-cases and cushion-covers etc. But most important of all, is that they feel good to listen to the Word of God and receive the joy of our Lord Jesus.

These women who attended ICM's sewing ministry have increased confidence to speak in public as well as at the Christmas celebration that they had the courage to dance on the stage even it was the first time dancing in their life, they felt so much joy during the Christmas Celebration. They are very open to share their feelings and seek prayers from the ICM staff. They feel a sense of belonging and a second home. That's why they love to drop by anytime they feel like, even if there is not any program in ICM. Still, I have been learning many things from the sewing ministry and in the future, I shall be teaching what I have learned.

I would like to thank each and every person that has been supporting ICM Sewing ministry through prayers and opening their hearts in providing various materials. Thank you.

YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY REPORT



In April 2023, our youth director has a serious health issues due to failure in both of his kidneys, and had to go to Nepal for transplant. It was really a challenging moment for his family and for us as staff as well. However, by God's grace we were able to launch some young adults' program with the help of our hard working staff and volunteers. Mini Discipleship training program is one of the significant programs that have brought a huge impact in the lives of our young adults. Especially to those who are struggling with mental health issues and addictions. Many have encountered Jesus and found the meaning of life.

DOWN TOWN MINISTRY (Ministry to recovery brothers)

Addiction is a problem that can be both public and hidden. There are those on the streets who are obviously suffering. Then there are others who go unnoticed, but just beneath the surface are spinning in chaos. Likely, the problem of addiction exists in our community, and it's probably a bigger issue than we realize.

Ministering to addicts is tough. For every success story, there are 100 failures. Just when you think recovery is about to begin, addiction sweeps a person away again.

In Inner City Ministries, once every month we go to see our brothers and sisters living under the flyover and footbridge to provide food and counselling. Besides, we go to visit our recovery brothers in drug rehabilitation center twice every month. We were able to provide over 120 hours counselling program, visits and medical assistance. Two brothers got baptized and over 30 brothers have given their lives to Jesus.

In 2017, I was diagnosed with IgA nephropathy, a rare disease that causes kidney damage when our immune system produces antibodies in our kidneys.

Last year, my kidney condition worsened, leading to my urgent hospitalization for dialysis. It was a heavy and overwhelming situation, given my desperate need for a kidney donor. But by the grace of God, my mother turned out to be the ideal match for me. Despite this hopeful element, it was an incredibly tough period for my family and me. We had to go through several medical check-ups, navigate complex legal procedures, and handle the financial burden that came with it. n this challenging time of my life, the support and prayers from Inner City Ministries greatly aided us in our kidney transplant journey in Nepal. Their assistance extended not just to financial matters but also in caring for my family in Hong Kong.

I am forever grateful to all the donors and supporters of Inner City Ministries for your selflessness and generosity. The impact of your donation goes beyond just the financial support; it has given me a second chance at life.

COMMUNITY CARE MINISTRY

When I visited them they invited their non-believer friends, prepared food, and asked me to share the gospel. Some of their friends had accepted the Lord and they followed them up a few months later some of them got baptised.

I met a group of young boys on the street. They greet

me saying "Jai Mashi" aunty, which means "Praise Massiah" in Nepali. They used to come to ICM for Kids Club and Teens fellowship. They said, they still

remember the songs and some Bible verses they learned in ICM. One of them invited me to see his

new-born baby and pray for him.





I would like to highlights a group of families with whom we shared the gospel in Chung King Mansion. Three families from that group got baptized and attended the local Church in their area.

This year they did a Christmas outreach, cooked some delicacies, and invited their non-believers to the Church. The local church has provided the venue. So, they all work and labour together for the lost souls to bring them to the kingdom of God. It reminds me of "Psalm 133:1, how good it is for brothers and sisters to work together in Unity to extend His Kingdom. Through Home fellowship, they have encouraged those backsliders, who were not going to the Church or any fellowship since they are in the UK.



I thank God that we are called to the great commission of Jesus to preach, teach disciples, and seek the Lost, so they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in Jesus. Acts 26:18,

At present, as we continue to share gospel ministering to our ladies at sewing class, some of them are drawing closer to God and want to follow Jesus by getting baptized. We have the privilege to pray with them and teach them to pray for their children through the Moms In Prayers fellowship every Friday.

This gospel magic show was intended to present the Christian good news through visual parables. The kids loved it and I myself was having a blast. Using this approach, I believe the kids were able to understand and contour some of the stories from the Bible, which has a lasting effect.

Celebrating Easter with the kids and their parents was also very memorable. Community Church HK not only provided us with the venue but with their manpower as well. As a result we had a bigger space and involvement of 50-60 families making this Easter Gospel programs a hit. That's what I love about the Christian community and the faithfulness of God.

All these series of measures perfectly aligned with the preparation of the Vacation Bible School. Surely our summer is filled with back-to-back programs, but I was reminded that ministry's not an option for a Christian, but a privilege. Being able to be aware of the needs in our community and being willing to step in and help, it's a privilege to serve others and share God's love. Hence, the theme of "Shine Jesus' Light" fitted perfectly at that time. We had over 60 kids joined our VBS program this year.

Another blessing came to us in a disguise. The Family outing to Noah's Ark was a huge success and this was the first massive outing after a long time due to covid. The parents were sharing with me that they felt it quite refreshing to be able to go out with all the community. So once again, whenever there is a need, I personally have seen the needs being reached. Witnessing such grace from God strengthens my faith and once more motivates me to do what I do.



During the Christmas community program, most of the kids performed and especially the parents of the ones who did the Nepali cultural dance shared that they felt proud of their kids. The reason being, growing up in Hong Kong does not give them a good deal of opportunity to soak in with their own culture, music and dance. I felt like this could also be an encouragement for the kids to participate more in the future programs. It is humbling to be in the presence of such overwhelming joy, and I am reminded that God is always working to bring joy and hope to those in need.

However many were blessed on that day to receive the Good news by our Youth as actions speak louder than words can ever explain. First Summer with Youths:

We were so very grateful to God as He opened the path to run our Summer Program "KINGDOM WARRIORS" to our Youth in 2023, as the main theme was "JOURNEY TO FREEDOM", and we were looking forward to seeing them learn how walking with God can bring freedom in their lives, and there were doubts in the beginning as a few of them were not free from school as they needed to attend their extracurricular activities.

However, by God's grace, we had a total of 13 participants and 4 volunteers who joined and which brought out a fruitful outcome for our Youth. They went home with an open heart to learn more about who God is and how He walks with them in their Journey to Freedom.

As a new chapter unfolds for these Youth, it's exciting to see how God will unravel their life and how He will push these Youths to do great things for His Kingdom, please continue to keep our ministry in your prayers as they are a fragile soul in a big world that is not kind at all times, it is only in God that they can find comfort and love.






