congregation in making
disciples for Jesus Christ.

FAQs

Length of Renewal Leave

It varies....usually 2-4 months.

Meeting Church Needs

In consultation with the District Superintendent, and Big Sigh Ministries, the pastor finds someone to preach and someone to fulfill pastoral care needs. Retired clergy are a wonderful resource.

Financial Obligations

The church pays their already budgeted obligation: the Pastor's salary and housing continues, travel allowance is paid to pastoral care fill-in, pulpit supply can be compensated by church, pastor, district, or some other means as negotiated. Big Sigh Ministries may be able to help.
