We anticipate about 40 baskets will be provided to families in our community this year. If you would like to create a basket, you can sign up after any of the Masses on the weekend of October 25th-26th in the rear of the atrium.



- During last year’s winter, Outreach was able to provide 100 gallons of emergency oil to some households as a direct result of your generosity. If you would like to help keep a family warm this winter by donating, please mark “Fuel Assistance” on your envelope.



- Participate in our Christmas “Be An Angel” program. Again this year, we will provide gift cards to the families Outreach assists throughout the year and gifts for several other agencies. This program will run from November 8th through December 7th. Future bulletins will contain important information on this year’s Christmas Angel program.
