Our Gospel calls us to see and help those in need. This is an invitation to put our faith into action by simple acts that can make a big difference. Our Outreach pantry is accessed by families, like yours, every week. This Lent, we are inviting you to join us in keeping the shelves full and helping to feed our neighbors in need.

How it works:

To help, we are asking each grade to donate their assigned pantry item and return it on their assigned weekend.

We are only asking for one item per student.
