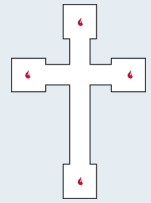

## 4:00AM INSIGHTS

*Weekly Reflection by Fr. Michael*



Most of the time I get a good night's sleep of 6-7 hours. Every once in a while I wake up in the middle of the night, and I know I am not going to fall back to sleep. On those occasions, I will get up and usually am very focused and creative in doing some bit of parish work. This past Monday was one of those nights. I woke up and was aware that because of vacation schedules I have a deadline for several bulletin letters. It was time for me to get up and start writing although I did not have any great ideas as to what I should write.

It was a delightful summer morning. It was cool enough to be refreshing and energizing but not cold enough that I needed a jacket. I took my flashlight and began to walk over to the office. I quickly realized I did not need the flashlight as Mother Nature was providing all the light I needed. It was one or two nights past a full moon and the sky was amazingly bright. As I walked on the path over to the office the moon was at my back. My shadow was outlined by a gentle blue light that broke through the trees. I felt like it was the kind of scene that would be portrayed in a fairy tale. As soon as I got to the parking lot, I could not help but notice there were only two stars visible in the sky, but they were as bright as could be. It was well received, and we will begin to offer it to those already involved in ministry as well as newcomers who are looking to get involved.
- Unfortunately, I have not had any success in resolving my issues with EZ-Pass of NJ. It's hard to address a problem when there is no way to speak to anyone, so I keep writing letters. Will they, perhaps, respond one day?

Have a great week. Should you happen to drive through our parking lot in the wee hours of the morning and see me wandering around, don't worry, I'm just trying to get inspired to write a bulletin column.

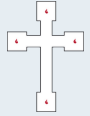
This week, ask a friend to pray with you about your struggles to live boldly as a Christian.
