HAPPY PENTECOST

Today the Church celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit. The past fifteen months have given profound witness to the power of the Spirit. In spite of unprecedented obstacles, we continued to function as a faith community. Ministries continued and needs were met on all levels of parish life. At times, innovation and creativity were needed to carry on the work, but indeed great things happened. So many parishioners demonstrated their love for this community by an outpouring of support. We look forward to happy days ahead, but we know that the Lord will continue to be at work in our hearts in spite of whatever challenges we face.

The Spirit was rocking our Worship Area on Monday and Wednesday of this week. We offered almost 100 of our Level 8 students a Confirmation Retreat in anticipation of their receiving the Sacrament this autumn. Mr. Tony Belizzi led the evenings of prayer. He is a charismatic man who engages our young people. There are elements of fun woven into the evening as well as a powerful message. We are so pleased we were able to offer this in-person experience as an option for our Confirmation candidates. There will be prayer cards available at the Masses this weekend in which you will be invited to pray for one of our candidates.

This is the first weekend when we are back to 100% capacity. All pews will be available for use. I don't anticipate that there will be any problems with the increased capacity. With the exception of one Mass on Easter, we never hit the point where we needed to close our doors. A few Masses have gotten a bit crowded, but I am not aware of any situations where people felt uncomfortable. I don't think there will be a surge in attendance. More people have been coming back since Easter, but normally numbers drop during the summer. We hope that common sense and good judgment will prevail and people will continue to leave a comfortable amount of space. Of course, we will monitor the situation and address any issues if they should arise. Some folks may be more comfortable than others with the relaxed restrictions. Be mindful that everyone is working through this process at his or her own pace. Please be respectful of those who may continue to seek a bit of distance.

I received a message from Fr. Jim McNamara. He will be visiting in the states for at least a few weeks in the summer. He will be here at Holy Cross on Sunday, June 6, celebrating the 11:30 Mass. Mark your calendars and plan on stopping by to say "hello."

The Spirit of Knowledge, that I may know God and know myself and grow more perfect in the science of the Saints,


The Spirit of Piety, that I may find peace and fulfillment in the service of God while serving others,
