WHAT IF WE DIDN'T TELL THE STORY?

Today is the day when we tell the Resurrection story. The calendar identifies the correct date. All the liturgical prayers and scripture readings lead up to this point. There are expectations for the story to be told once a year at this time. Ready or not, it's Easter.

There are times when proclaiming resurrection and embracing new life do not feel genuine, as it does not mirror what surrounds us. Two years ago we were telling the Easter story when the doors of the church were locked in the midst of the Covid shutdown. Today, we are now dealing with a war half a world away. It's not as though telling the Easter story takes away our problems. Wouldn't it make more sense to wait until things were going better? Then the joyful story would be reflected in the circumstances of life. The circumstances of life should not dictate the telling of the story of salvation. Rather, the story of salvation needs to be understood in light of our lives, whether we are in the midst of good times or struggles. We are called to believe that the power of the Risen Christ is stronger than any challenge we will face. So yes, we tell the story in good times and in bad.

People who live heroic lives find strength even in the midst of the greatest trials. Read the life of virtually any saint. They did not do great works because the circumstances of life made it easy to do so. Rather, they had the perspective to see the potential for good. They had the faith to believe that God's presence in their lives would be their source. This inner strength comes from a place that goes beyond any of us. It is the spirit of the Risen Lord at work through our words and actions.

If we do not tell the story, we fail to remind ourselves of what happened. If we do not tell the story, we run the risk of allowing war, hate, and suffering to overwhelm us. If we do not tell the story, the common foundation we share is lost. The Easter proclamations become that point of reference which defines us. It is our true source of hope. We don't have to go in search of meaning. We don't have to create a story of life on our own. We simply share in what Christ has won for each of us, once for all.

We tell the story again, it hasn't changed. But our lives continue to move forward. Time and time again we come to appreciate what it means for us that we share in the gift of the Risen Lord. He is Risen, Alleluia. Life and hope to all!

A blessed Easter to you and your loved ones.



Walking with grief after losing a loved one is as unique as our fingerprints! It can be as if all color in our world is gray.




Having time to listen to others dealing with grief can often give us new insights, thus, allowing us to share our pathway and gain ways to move forward, putting some color back in our world!

Easter 2022

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Christ is Risen, Alleluia!

Every Easter, as we celebrate our Lord's victory over death, we delight in the consolation that all is restored through the Resurrection, and we ponder God's relentless invitation to live the divine life given at baptism.

This is the good news of our faith: Christ has conquered death and we are invited to life. This good news needs to be heard time and again. Even when things are bleak, we remember Christ is victorious and that we have been invited to witness to his victory. As Pope Francis says:

"Where all seems to be dead, signs of the resurrection suddenly spring up. It is an irresistible force. Often it seems that God does not exist: all around us we see persistent injustice, evil, indifference and cruelty. But it is also true that in the midst of darkness something new always springs to life and sooner or later produces fruit. On razed land life breaks through, stubbornly yet invincibly. However dark things are, goodness always re-emerges and spreads. Each day in our world beauty is born anew, it rises transformed through the storms of history. Values always tend to reappear under new guises, and human beings have arisen time after time from situations that seemed doomed. Such is the power of the resurrection, and all who evangelize are instruments of that power."¹

We know well the bleakness that can overwhelms us. How good it is to recall God's goodness! The Risen Lord moves through the locked doors of fear to lead us, to lead our families and to lead the world to peace. May we never forget God's triumph over death and our baptismal call to be an instrument of that power. May we show the Risen Lord to all we meet.

This Easter, as we rejoice in Christ's Resurrection, let us remember especially those who suffer in Ukraine and the millions who have been displaced by that tragic war. Together, we pray that the Risen Christ bring light to their darkness and give them peace.

Be assured of my prayers for you in these holy and joyful weeks.
