## SAILING, SAILING...

by Father Michael

As most of you are reading this, the Travel Club is sailing into Boston Harbor on our 7-day New England and Canadian cruise. There is a total of 37 travelers making the journey. While in port some of us plan to work our way over to the Holy Cross Cathedral for Mass. We are looking forward to some fun days on the ship at the other ports we will visit as well. Unfortunately, our departure was a bit more complicated than we had hoped for. There was a requirement to provide a negative Covid test taken within 72 hours of departure. It was a little stressful making sure everyone secured the proper test and received the results before we sailed. In addition, visitors to Canada are required to fill out an on-line declaration in order to visit the country. This too had to be done within 72 hours of departure. Once on board, all should be well. These are some of the complications associated with travel these days.

On Wednesday of this week, Bishop Andrzej Zglejszewski visited Holy Cross to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for 100 of our young people. The last two years, pastors were given permission to celebrate the Sacrament within the parish. This was because, with limited seating capacities due to Covid, there would have been too many services for the bishops to handle. We enjoyed celebrating the Sacrament on a parish level, but we also welcome back the tradition of having a bishop visit for the occasion.

I am looking to start a Buildings and Grounds Committee to help evaluate the condition of our facilities. The building is now nearing 30 years old, and there are maintenance issues and repairs that need to be addressed. I will be inviting parishioners who have expertise in particular areas to help me assess these needs. I am looking for some additional folks who may be able to share their knowledge of what needs to be done. In particular, I am looking for folks who have expertise in the fields of both electrical and plumbing. If you think you may be able to help, please let me know.

I'm happy to announce I will be starting a Men's Prayer Group. Male spirituality was an important part of my own spiritual journey. In the 90s, I made several retreats in the Southwest that deeply touched me. I was able to bring some of those insights to the communities I served at that time. I was even able to use some of it when I was chaplain at the high school. I am now looking to offer this here at Holy Cross. The first meeting is going to be Saturday, October 1st, at 9:00 AM in the chapel. I am hoping to get a small group of men who are open to explore this aspect of spirituality.

(Background screening is conducted on all volunteers and employees every 5 years.)

#### **Directions to Complete the 3 Requirements:**

- 1. Sign up to attend a Protecting God's Children class: <a href="www.Virtus.org">www.Virtus.org</a> When you log on to the Virtus website, you will create a Virtus account.
  - a. If you have not attended a Virtus class, you are a first-time registrant.
  - b. The first screen will ask the name of your organization from the drop down list select Rockville Centre-Safe Environment.
  - c. Follow all directions on the next screens.
  - d. One screen will have the Codes of Conduct. Please acknowledge the Codes of Conduct.
  - Continue with the registration process and select the class you will attend.
  - f. After selecting the class, you will be instructed to complete the background screening application.
  - 2. Background Screening Application:
    - a. Sterling Volunteers is the company providing the background screening.
    - b. Follow all the directions to complete the background screening application. DO NOT STOP ONCE YOU BEGIN THE APPLICATION! If you stop-you are locked out of the process due to security procedures.
    - c. You will need to provide your Social Security #; if you do not provide a Social Security # you will be charged a fee.
    - After completing the application, hit the 'Submit Button'
