# **Ordinary Time**

There are two blocks of time within the Liturgical year when we celebrate what is known as Ordinary Time. This is the season in which we now find ourselves. It will continue through Ash Wednesday, which is on March 6. Ordinary Time is not meant to mean mediocre or uneventful. It is ordered or numbered time. Green vestments are worn throughout the season. That color is sometimes described to be symbolic of a time of growth and hope. It is not a time of our greatest celebrations, but it is the time where our lives move forward open to the work of the Spirit among us.

Last week it was announced that the elementary school at St. Joseph's in Ronkonkoma will be closing at the end of the academic year. On paper the decision makes sense. Enrollment has been declining and parish subsidy has steadily been rising. It was simply no longer feasible to keep the place going. But aside from facts and figures is the human factor. There is always sadness and/or anger when something that was an important part of the lives of individuals or a parish cannot be sustained. We pray for that community as they face this significant moment in their history.

We often associate the word "happy" with an anniversary. And many times, anniversaries are happy occasions. But there can also be difficult anniversaries. This week was the first anniversary of my Mom's death. I was surprised at how much of a challenge it was. It wasn't as though I was constantly recalling the events that surrounded her death. I did not choose to dwell on those memories, but there was a wave of emotion that came to life on it's own. I am grateful for all the ways in which family, friends, and parishioners have reached out. Simply having others share in the moment is a great source of comfort.

Moments like this are unavoidable in life. It is kind of like a passing thunderstorm. You may see it coming, you may want to avoid it, but it has to move along and do its thing. And the good news is, it does pass by. We do what we need to do to minimize how the storm may affect us, but in the end we ride it out and then move forward. I am most appreciative to the many people who have been so supportive and caring during this time.

The response to our first Valentine Sweetheart Dance has been strong. If you are interested, don't wait until the last minute to respond. We don't want to have to turn anyone way. Remember, parish offices are closed on Monday for the Martin Luther King holiday.




