

Happy October

Last weekend was painful for many. For those who know Fr. Bill, there was a great sadness in hearing the news of the accusations made against him. We continue to pray for him while the investigation is underway to determine what happened so many years ago. Please see the separate notice in this bulletin providing more information regarding this difficult situation. Prayers for one and all, please.

This article was written on Monday, so I hope to be able to report this weekend that I survived the annual blessing of animals which took place this past Thursday on the Feast of St. Francis. Although I am not a "pet person" myself, I am happy to bless these little critters that bring joy to so many people.

We had someone dump a fiberglass shell/hull of a Waverunner/Sea-doo in the woods in the corner of the parking lot. With the help of the police and a bit of detective work on the part of Deacon Ralph, we found the person who owned it three years ago when it was last registered. We are trying to work with the former owner so that we do not have to absorb the cost of having it removed from our property.

As you know, we have been diligent in addressing issues of maintenance of our parish property. We have completed major projects such as the new roof and repaving the parking lot. We also try to keep on top of smaller repairs as they are needed. The next wave of work that needs to be done will be taking place in the Parish House. While I don't want to go over-the-top in spending money, it needs to be acknowledged that the place needs attention. The renovation of the kitchen is on the top of the list. We are in the midst of designing it, and I hope work will begin within a month or so. There are additional, significant items that need attention. The laminate floors throughout most of the house are popping up, and a beautiful tile floor in my den has just started cracking and coming loose. Two of the bathrooms are becoming "unglued" with wallpaper peeling and floor tiles no longer staying in place. Repairs will be prioritized and done at a reasonable pace, but there will be a bit of a makeover happening at 85 Nichols Rd.

There is an interesting statistic to report from our Religious Ed Office. Registration for the First Communion program, which begins in First Grade, is down significantly. Last year we had over 80 sign up. This year the number has not yet hit 50. This seems to be an issue of demographics, as many of our local parishes are also reporting a significant decline in registration. By all means, if you have a child that you want to be part of our Religious Education program, now is the time to be in touch with our Religious Ed Office.





Highlights of Fiscal Year 2017-18:

- Collections received are flat for the year.
- Program Revenues are down \$4,000 over last year due to a decrease in Outreach donations.
- We received a one time gift from a parishioner's estate of \$69,000 this fiscal year.
- Our payroll costs are lower this fiscal year due to a decrease in staffing in some departments.
- Snow removal costs increased \$8,000 this fiscal year over last.
- Year to Date our surplus is \$97,000 vs. \$158,000 last year. However, we did the parking lot repair in this fiscal year, which was offset, in part, by donations from our parking lot mailing as well as a large memorial donation this year.
- We paid off our MAC loan this fiscal year and our debt is now at zero.
