Due to an early deadline for the holiday, this article is being written before Thanksgiving. However, I think it is a reasonable expectation to believe my title has some truth to it. In some ways, the leftovers can be even better than the meal itself. I hope everyone had a day that was filled with moments of gratitude for the blessings of your life. I am grateful to Fr. Frank who was able to celebrate our morning Mass on Thanksgiving so that I could be with my sister in Florida.

My doctors have been more than encouraging me to be mindful of my diet. Not only is there the hope of knocking a few notches off the scale, but also of keeping those ever-important biometric numbers (or whatever they call it) balanced. I have to say, I made great success over the past two months. But, it is remarkable how easily that progress can be lost over a few bountiful feasts. May the beginning of this new Church year be an opportunity for you to grow closer to the Lord and realize the many ways in which He is abundantly present in your life.

Thank you to all the helping hands last week after the 11:30 Mass. We were able to change all the song books in record-setting time of about 13 minutes. Many folks even took the old books home so that they could be recycled. Happy Advent!

The Sacrament will be offered after the 9:30 Mass this Sunday, December 1st.



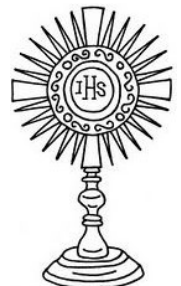

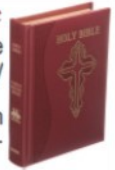
