

# **A Blessed Memorial Day**

Traditionally, this is the first unofficial weekend of the summer. There is nothing wrong with welcoming the season we associate with fun and relaxation. But, we cannot overlook the holiday that creates this weekend. As world politics become more complicated and intense, the role of those who serve in the military becomes even more vital. It often takes difficult times for us to appreciate the work others have done. This weekend as a nation, we honor all those who gave their lives in service to our country. We remember all those many people who have gone before us. We pray for their families who still grieve their loss. We pray for our Nation and those who continue to serve it. We pray for peace.

The latest saga with my Jeep has come to a conclusion. Back in January, with barely 40,000 miles, the transmission completely failed. # **RELIGIOUS FORMATION**

## **Welcome to Holy Cross Religious Education**

The Religious Education Office is planning ahead to the 2018-2019 Formation Year. We need your help so that we can adequately plan to meet the needs of our parish. If you have a child entering **First Grade in September you need to register.** If you have recently moved to our parish you need to register in the parish. Our program is "home based." Classes do not take place at the Church; rather they are held in the homes of our Catechists. Because of this, there are geographical limits on who we are able to accommodate. Please contact our office for more specific information.

- First time registration needs to be done in person at our office.
- Registration needs to be completed by June 15, 2018.
- Office Hours: Monday Friday 9:00-12:00 & 1:00-4:00
- If your child was not baptized at Holy Cross you need to bring a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate.
- For those who are already part of our program, you need to re-register for the upcoming year. Materials have been sent to your home early in May and they may be returned by mail. Please note the deadline of June 15, 2018.

A detailed outline of our program is available on-line or at our office. But, there are a few important details to be noted.

- Children must successfully complete each grade level to proceed to the next.
- The Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation require a minimum of two years of preparation.

Most importantly, we need to work together. Faithful attendance at classes and parent

workshops is essential. As comprehensive and informative as our program is, this is only one part of your child's faith formation. The greatest thing you can do to nurture your faith and the faith of your child is to regularly be part of our Sunday Eucharist.

The Catechism of the Church states that parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. We are privileged to work with you in this task. We thank you for your cooperation in allowing us to be part of your lives. We look forward to a fruitful year where everyone, young and old, continues to grow in understanding the gift of our faith.

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops supports both the Dream Act and the USA Act. The Dream Act remains the ideal legislative solution. And, while the USA Act can still be improved upon, as written it is a compromise bill that provides a path to citizenship for 1.8 million Dreamers and offers proportionate border security measures. We are urging the House of Representatives to urgently move forward these pieces of legislation. Dear Mr. Zeldin:

As a person of faith, I believe in protecting the God-given dignity of every human being. Consequently, I urge you to work towards a solution for Dreamers and vote to advance the USA Act of 2018, H.R. 4796. This bill has strong bipartisan support and is a thoughtful, compassionate, and reasonable compromise that would protect Dreamers, improve border security, address root causes of migration from Central America's most violent countries, and provide immigration courts with the staffing they need. I also urge you to continue advancement of the Dream Act, H.R. 3440, a legislative measure protecting Dreamers that the U.S. Catholic Bishops have long supported. These items should be moved forward for debate and a vote as soon as possible.

As you work towards a legislative solution for Dreamers, I also ask you to remember the sanctity of families and vulnerability of unaccompanied immigrant children. Vulnerable children and asylum-seekers are people in critical need of protection; they are not "loopholes." Similarly, families are the backbone of our society and deserve to have the opportunity to reunify and grow together.

The Catholic community stands with you in supporting humane and common-sense legislative solutions for Dreamers, and we thank you for your work.

## **RELIGIOUS FREEDOM**

On Memorial Day, while we honor our deceased veterans, we should be aware that even today they are being attacked – this time by freedom-from-religion groups.

In 1934, the VFW erected the Mojave Desert Veterans Memorial Cross in the middle of the 1.6 millionacre Mojave Desert, CA, in honor of WWI veterans. In 2001, the ACLU brought a lawsuit, from one individual, an out-of-stater. Fortunately, in 2010 the U.S. Supreme Court allowed the cross to be restored. "The veterans earned this memorial," said a Liberty Institute attorney.

A 40-foot-tall World War I memorial in the shape of a cross has stood for almost a century in MD. The U.S. Court of Appeals has declared this Peace Cross to be unconstitutional. Defenders of the cross are planning to take the case to the Supreme Court, arguing that the ruling sets a dangerous precedent, threatening other national treasures.

A Memorial Day display, honoring 79 residents who died in America's wars, featured 79 white, handmade crosses, which were posted along a state highway in Georgia. The crosses were taken down when just one person complained about the display. "It was never about religion – it was to honor them," said Mayor Philyaw. "The cross is a 'rest in peace' symbol to me."


