Over the Falls in a Barrel

This weekend, I am traveling with 38 parishioners on our spring adventure to Niagara Falls and Toronto. I am happy to report that we will be viewing the falls from the safety of dry land (except for the boat ride at the base of the falls). We will not be following in the footsteps of the many daredevils who have attempted the falls with dangerous stunts. I think I was in the fourth grade when I visited the falls for the first time. I have happy memories of taking a bus tour with my family which introduced me to this great natural wonder. On Sunday morning we will be attending Mass at St. Michael's Cathedral in Toronto. I always enjoy opportunities to travel, and I am delighted that I can share some of them with parishioners. (As I am away this weekend, Holy Hour and Anointing of the Sick will take place next weekend.)

I enjoyed the holiday last Monday. In addition to relaxing a bit, I like days like this to catch up on projects. I did a few outdoor chores around the yard that were overdue. And, I came to the office early in the morning. One of the things I found myself doing was canceling out all sorts of crazy e-mails that keep coming in like the tides. It's remarkable how you find yourself on lists from companies and organizations that you have no interest in whatsoever. I think I must have hit the "unsubscribe" button about two dozen times. I hope this will make my cyber-life a little less cluttered.

Some of our young people may be a little nervous about a meeting they have this week at the parish. One of the requirements introduced by the Diocese a few years back, is that all Confirmation candidates have a "conversation" with someone from the church regarding their readiness to receive the Sacrament. It is not meant to be an oral exam where the students are asked difficult questions. It is an opportunity for each student to meet with someone from the parish. We invite Catechists and other parishioners who are trained for this discussion. It gives an opportunity to discuss what our young people have learned about our faith. It gives them an opportunity to identify how or what God may have been teaching them through these years of preparation. I hope none of our young people are losing sleep with worry over this one; it is all pretty easy.

The painting in the chapel is complete. There are a few other things, like new carpeting around the altar to come. I was hoping everything could be completed in one week, but sometimes our greatest plans wander off-track.

Next week is Pentecost. You are invited to wear something red to Mass as that is the liturgical color for the day. I will also give you a sneak preview into our theme for the day. The phrase of the day is "who will . . ." Hang in there, more to come on that next week.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Welcome to Holy Cross Religious Education

The Religious Education Office is planning ahead to the 2019-2020 Formation Year. We need your help so that we can adequately plan to meet the needs of our parish. If you have a child entering **First Grade in September you need to register**. If you have recently moved to our parish you need to register in the parish. Our program is "home based." Classes do not take place at the Church; rather they are held in the homes of our Catechists. Because of this, there are geographical limits on who we are able to accommodate. Please contact our office for more specific information.

- First time registration needs to be done in person at our office.
- Registration needs to be completed by June 14, 2019.
- Office Hours: Monday – Friday 9:00-12:00 & 1:00-4:00
- If your child was not baptized at Holy Cross you need to bring a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate.
- For those who are already part of our program, you need to re-register for the upcoming year. **Materials have been sent to your home in May**, and they may be returned by mail. Please note the deadline of June 14, 2019.

A detailed outline of our program is available on-line or at our office. But, there are a few important details to be noted.

- Children must successfully complete each grade level to proceed to the next.
- The Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation require a minimum of two years of preparation.

Most importantly, we need to work together. Faithful attendance at classes and parent workshops is essential. As comprehensive and informative as our program is, this is only one part of your child's faith formation. The greatest thing you can do to nurture your faith and the faith of your child is to regularly be part of our Sunday Eucharist.

The Catechism of the Church states that parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. We are privileged to work with you in this task. We thank you for your cooperation in allowing us to be part of your lives. We look forward to a fruitful year where everyone, young and old, continues to grow in understanding the gift of our faith.






