I always enjoy these days of June, mostly because of how long the sun is out each day. Unfortunately, this year much of the sunshine has been displaced by clouds, rain and fog. But, nonetheless, it is summer. Understandably, these are happy days for students and those who work in education as they complete another year and look forward to some vacation time.

This week the Pastoral Team and Staff had our Annual Evaluation and Planning Meeting. As long as one is not spiritually asleep, there will be many opportunities for new ministerial offerings, and we hope to bring some of those to life here at Holy Cross. We spoke about some changes in our Religious Education program both for catechists and our students. We are already looking to create a Lenten Mission. There are some improvements we are investigating with such things as our sound system and landscaping of parish grounds. We want Holy Cross to be a place where there is a vibrancy that attracts people to share in our life and to nourish parishioners in their relationship with the Lord.

Creative planning can be fun. But, none of that could happen if we did not have the foundation upon which to build and create more. We are blessed here at Holy Cross for many reasons. We have many caring people who are deeply involved in the life of the parish. On a practical level, we have the resources to maintain a balanced budget and still have a bit left over for imaginative new ideas. There are some parishes where financial deficits create obstacles that stifle the spirit. Thank you to all of you who put us in this good position. Your commitment and support of the parish are deeply appreciated.

This weekend six men will be ordained to priesthood in Rockville Centre. This is a relatively large number. In the coming years, it looks like the number of candidates will be far fewer. While most parts of Church life continue to function as always, the days are not far off when the shortage of available priests will impact parish life. I can see one area here at Holy Cross where that may become a reality. I don't plan on doing a lot of travel this summer. One of the details that needs to be worked out, for when I am not here, is Mass coverage. So far, getting coverage for Sunday Mass has not been a problem. However, weekday Masses are getting a little tricky. We will continue to do our best to get all the slots filled, but there may be some weekdays when we are not able to offer Mass. The Holy Spirit will continue to lead and guide our Church, but there may be a need for a change in expectations in how life in the Church will get lived out.

Enjoy these summer days.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Welcome to Holy Cross Religious Education

The Religious Education Office is planning ahead to the 2019-2020 Formation Year. We need your help so that we can adequately plan to meet the needs of our parish. If you have a child entering **First Grade in September you need to register**. If you have recently moved to our parish you need to register in the parish. Our program is "home based." Classes do not take place at the Church; rather they are held in the homes of our Catechists. Because of this, there are geographical limits on who we are able to accommodate. Please contact our office for more specific information.

- First time registration needs to be done in person at our office.
- Registration needs to be completed by June 28, 2019.
- Office Hours: Monday – Friday 9:00-12:00 & 1:00-4:00
- If your child was not baptized at Holy Cross you need to bring a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate.
- For those who are already part of our program, you need to re-register for the upcoming year. **Materials have been sent to your home in May**, and they may be returned by mail. Please note the deadline of June 28, 2019.

A detailed outline of our program is available on-line or at our office. But, there are a few important details to be noted.

- Children must successfully complete each grade level to proceed to the next.
- The Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation require a minimum of two years of preparation.

Most importantly, we need to work together. Faithful attendance at classes and parent workshops is essential. As comprehensive and informative as our program is, this is only one part of your child's faith formation. The greatest thing you can do to nurture your faith and the faith of your child is to regularly be part of our Sunday Eucharist.



The Catechism of the Church states that parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. We are privileged to work with you in this task. We thank you for your cooperation in allowing us to be part of your lives. We look forward to a fruitful year where everyone, young and old, continues to grow in understanding the gift of our faith.


Heifer Corner: 15 Years and Counting

This year marks our 15th year of supporting Heifer International. What an accomplishment!

Our little collection pig, "Kevin Bacon," has become intrinsically a part of the Holy Cross community. Each time "Kevin" is filled up with quarters, we have enough to purchase a pig from Heifer.



Because of your generosity, we have purchased many pigs, heifers, goats, chicks, bees, rabbits and llamas over the years. In fact, we have given Heifer over \$42,000 to assist families in struggling areas of the world. Each recipient of a Heifer animal or grant must pass on the gift. So, innumerable families have been helped through our support of Heifer!




In honor of our 15th anniversary year, we have donated \$540 to purchase 2 sheep, 4 honeybee packages and 3 tree seedlings. The sheep will provide high-quality wool which families can weave into clothes or sell for income. Because bees will pollinate, a healthy beehive can double fruit and vegetable yields. Tree seedlings help a family form a small orchard, and then families use the sale of fruits, nuts and pollen to pay for a child's education.
