Happy Independence Day

This Wednesday our Nation celebrates a holiday. (Our offices will be closed, but there will be a 9:00 morning Mass.) While it is a great time to grill up some hot dogs and watch some fireworks, it is also a great time to be mindful of all the blessings we have in our country. We are aware of many corners of our world where there are people who do not enjoy the freedom or opportunities we do. It becomes a challenge for our Nation and our Church to embrace a spirit that shares the blessings we have received. We pray for wise leaders who can help foster this spirit. We continue to pray for all those who serve our Nation.

This past Tuesday marked my five-year anniversary in coming to Holy Cross. It is hard to believe how quickly time passes. The current policy is that pastors are assigned for six-year terms. If there are no difficulties within the parish or there is not a greater need somewhere else within the Diocese, a pastor can request an automatic second term. It is my plan to make that request, and I hope to remain here through 2025. The nature of diocesan priesthood is that we are moved on a regular basis and no assignment is guaranteed, but when there is a good relationship that works well for both priest and parishioners, there is no desire to break that dynamic.

There is a flyer in this bulletin advertising for a Pilgrimage to Oberammergau, which is the great Passion Play performed in Germany only one season every decade. I am happy to announce that I found a different tour company (Nawas Travel) which is offering a price of almost \$1,900 cheaper than what I previously announced. I am excited to make an offering like this which may now create the possibility for more people to participate. Another travel related note is that there are only a handful of seats remaining for the Lancaster trip in November. Please bring your check to the Parish Office as soon as possible if you are interested. I hate to turn folks away, but I only have a limited number of tickets.

Next weekend, if you come to the 11:30 Mass, you may notice a familiar face. Father Jim McNamara will celebrate the Mass. He has begun his summer break and is spending a few weeks here on Long Island. We look forward to welcoming him back to Holy Cross. Life in Rome has been going well for him, but it is always good to come home.

This evening I am leaving to get away for a few days, but I will be back before next weekend. I will be traveling with a colleague from St. John the Baptist High School. I appreciate the time off to relax and recharge the batteries a bit.





Highlights of Quarter and YTD:

- Collections received are up \$3,000 year to date. Easter is down \$1,475 over last year.
- Program Revenues are down \$9,000 over last year partly due to a \$4,000 decrease in Religious Education fees and a \$4,000 decrease in Outreach donations.
- We received a one time gift from a parishioner's estate of \$29,000 in April 2018.
- Our payroll costs are lower this fiscal year due to a decrease in staffing in some departments.
- We incurred snow removal expenses of \$16,906 this fiscal year as compared to last year of \$8,746.
- Year to Date our surplus is \$94,600 vs. \$160,500 last year at this time. However, we did the parking lot repair in this fisc al year, which was offset, in part, by donations from our parking lot mailing as well as a large memorial donation this year.


