

# A Mid Summer's Night Dream

Well, I really have not been having any unique dreams that I care to share with you. But, it was a colorful title to identify that we are just about at the midway point in the summer season. Don't get discouraged. There is still plenty of time to figure out what summer chores need to get done as well as to do some of the fun things you were hoping to get to. If you had some dreams of things you hoped to accomplish this summer, figure out how you can make that happen in the coming weeks. I will be out of the parish from August 1 – August 13. I am always grateful to my brother priests who cover the Masses while I am away. I am grateful to the Pastoral Team and Parish Staff who hold down the fort so that I am free to get some vacation time.

This past Tuesday I attended the ordination of our Diocese's newest auxiliary Bishop, Bishop Richard Henning. The ordination took place at St. Agnes Cathedral in Rockville Centre. There is no escaping the fact it is a long ceremony. But, there are some great traditions and unique rituals that are part of the Mass. As the prayers of ordination are offered, a book of the Gospels is held open over the bishop candidate's head. The prayers that speak of the duty of bishop are literally prayed in the shadow of the Gospel. At one point it gets a little sloppy as the Sacred Chrism oil gets poured on his head. And, there is something impressive about the tradition of laying on of hands on the one to be ordained. For those being ordained a bishop, only other bishops can lay on hands. At the ordination of a priest, all priests share in that tradition. We wish Bishop Henning well as he begins his new ministry within our Diocese.

Our Bishop, Bishop John Barres, has written a Pastoral Letter commemorating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Church Document, *Humane Vitae*. Many parts of that writing affirm the joy of married love and the sacred gift of human life. Copies of Bishop Barres' letter are available in the atrium.

We had a good turnout for the meeting to talk about our planned trip to Germany, Switzerland, and Austria in 2020. I am now taking deposits. Detailed information is available in the office. It is a little tricky making a deposit for a trip that is almost two years away. There is a lot of fine print which I can help translate for you if you might be interested in the tour.

Thank you to those who supported our Annual Summer Blood Drive. Approximately sixty people came out to donate blood. We appreciate those who make this unique and potentially life saving gift.

The Anointing of the Sick will be offered after the 9:30 Mass on Sunday, August 5th.






