

Tough Times

There is no escaping that the Church finds itself again in the midst of difficult times. The recent report from the Pennsylvania Grand Jury has left many people feeling angry, betrayed, sad, and a whole array of other emotions. I am grateful to all those who accepted my invitation to stay after Mass last weekend to share their feelings. There is no doubt that this issue creates a response that goes to the very core of many people. There were folks who were emotional as they shared their feelings. While I was not able to respond to parishioners' heartfelt concerns, I was happy at least to be able to provide a forum where folks could speak. By all means, I'm happy to speak with anyone who wishes to discuss this matter with me.

Much has been done since 2002 to create safeguards and more defined and appropriate responses. But it is clear there is still more to be done to eliminate the feelings of mistrust and doubt that remain. I am confident that more progress will be made to maintain a safe environment for all and to address the failings of the past. There are no simple solutions to offer. But I do believe the path to take is to deal with this within the context of faith and with the support of the community. There is life and support that grows when you know you are not alone. Holy Cross has a remarkable spirit that many people have come to discover. We need to allow that spirit to sustain and guide us as we move forward. For all of us, the gift of our faith is something deep and precious. We need to live that faith in the midst of stormy waters. We need to allow the power of the Spirit and the Risen Lord, which is greater than any challenge we will face on earth, be our hope as we move forward.

In spite of tough times, life in the parish continues to unfold in different ways. The Sacrament of Confirmation for our young people is quickly approaching in September. Over these next two weeks, with the help of some visiting priests, I will be hearing their confessions. Pray for our young people as they prepare for this sacrament.

There is something we thought would be a relatively minor repair that has taken on a life unto itself. The timer for the parking lot lights failed back in June. We bought a new electronic timer to replace the original old mechanical timer. But now for the life of us we cannot find an electrician who can install the new timer. Several have looked at the project but have walked away saying, "no thank you." It was not a problem during the summer as there are not a lot of evening meetings and it remains light well into the evening. But now that the new academic year approaches we need to get this installed.

Our evening consists of 3 parts:


- coffee (or tea!) and dessert,


