

Vacation Reflections

by Father Michael

I will be away until August 13. I am on a river cruise from Budapest to Nuremberg, Germany and then journeying on to Prague. (At least we hope it remains a river cruise. There are reports that the Danube River is running terribly low. There is a chance our river cruise might turn into a bus tour.) I am traveling with my sister and brother-in-law. This is the first major vacation I have taken in years that I have not been traveling with 46 of my closest friends; in other words, not a parish trip.

I am excited to be making this adventure trip as I have never been on a river cruise before, and I have never been to that corner of the world. My roots are Hungarian and German, so I am looking forward to visiting the homeland of my ancestors. Also, there is something else at work that is making this trip particularly special. I have a tremendous sense of freedom and new life.

For the last few years, much of my time and energy was focused on caring for my Mom. I am not at all complaining, nor am I resentful. It was a blessing to be able to care for her and help her with her needs. I had a very deep sense that God called me and this was my life work for that time. It was not as if I was a prisoner, I was not with her 24/7. There were others who helped with her care. There were many occasions when I was able to travel, and I had free time on my own. But, there was always a cloud of concern that followed me no matter where I was.

Part of my experience since January has been restructuring my life. Initially, there was the work of closing up her house, but now that is done. There are times when I instinctively want to pick up the phone to share some news with her. There are times when I am double checking in my mind that I don't need to be heading out to her house. I know I am not alone; many of you have gone through this experience as well. The connections with my Mom were strong and ran deep on many levels.

I miss her terribly. There has not been a day, and I suspect there will not be a day when I do not think of her. But I have to say, I now find myself experiencing a sense of tremendous freedom. There is a wave of new life coming into my life. There are times when I feel guilty that I find joy in these moments, but I know there is nothing wrong in this. I know my Mom struggled with feeling she was a burden to me. I know she is smiling on me as I make this trip. I know she wants me to embrace life and use well the opportunities I have. To be able to travel half way around the world and not have any emotional ties or worries to what is happening at home is a tremendous gift. (I assume the parish will still be standing when I return.)

God blesses (and challenges) us all in different ways. There are moments in this life when we deeply experience His dying and rising and know we receive His life. God is good.




