# RECEIVER'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF SECOND INTERIM FEE APPLICATION AND BRIEF IN SUPPORT

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Guy M. Hohmann, the Court-appointed Receiver in this action, files this Unopposed Motion for Approval of Second Interim Fee Application and Brief in Support ("Motion") and requests the Court's approval to pay invoices for interim fees and expenses of \$195,728.15 to the Receiver and retained professionals who rendered services to the ProphetMax Receivership Estate from October 1, 2012 to October 31, 2012. The Receiver believes this Motion and the supporting invoices demonstrate the reasonableness and necessity of the services rendered and the fees and expenses incurred for a receivership of this complexity. The Receiver also believes the fees and expenses discussed in this Motion reflect the peak of services rendered by the Receiver and his professionals to investigate, identify and pursue assets and records of the Estate, coordinate with governmental authorities, and communicate with investor victims. As discussed further below, the Receiver believes future monthly fees and expenses will decrease significantly over the remaining life of the Estate.

#### I. BACKGROUND

1. On September 18, 2012, the Court entered a Statutory Restraining Order ("Order") [Docket No. 4] appointing Guy M. Hohmann to serve as the Receiver for the assets of Defendants Senen Pousa, Investment Intelligence Corporation, *dba* ProphetMax Managed FX ("ProphetMax"), and Joel Friant, including the assets of their respective affiliates or subsidiaries (collectively, the "ProphetMax Receivership Estate" or "Estate"). *See* Order ¶ 11, 19. Under the Court's Order, the Receiver was given broad duties and powers to manage the Estate, which consists of both domestic and foreign Defendants, assets and records. As authorized under the Order, the Receiver has engaged a small, qualified team of professionals to aid the performance of his Court-ordered duties, including legal counsel from the law firm of Hohmann, Taube & Summers, L.L.P. *See id.* ¶ 20.i.

- 2. The Receiver files this Motion under paragraph 25 of the Order, which states that "[t]he Receiver and all personnel hired by the Receiver as herein authorized, including counsel to the Receiver, are entitled to reasonable compensation for the performance of duties pursuant to this Order and for the cost of actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred by them, from the assets now held by, or in the possession or control of, or which may be received by the Defendants." The Order directs the Receiver to file with the Court and serve on the parties periodic requests for the payment of such reasonable compensation. *Id*.
- 3. This Motion summarizes the time spent, services performed, hourly rates charged, and expenses incurred by the Receiver and his retained professionals from October 1, 2012 to October 31, 2012 (the "Second Fee Period"). These services are summarized below and described in detail in the redacted invoices filed with the Court, which the Receiver submits as Exhibits A through C in support of this Motion.<sup>1</sup>
- 4. This is the Receiver's second motion for approval to pay fees and expenses. The Receiver's first motion, which covered fees and expenses incurred from September 18, 2012 to September 30, 2012 (the "First Fee Period"), was granted by the Court on November 15, 2012. *See* Receiver's Unopposed Motion for Approval of First Interim Fee Application and Brief in Support ("First Fee Application") [Docket No. 30]; Order Granting Receiver's Unopposed Motion for Approval of First Interim Fee Application [Docket No. 40].

#### II. GENERAL SUMMARY OF SERVICES

5. Most of the work performed by the Receiver and his legal counsel (collectively, the "Receiver Team") during the Second Fee Period related to investigating, identifying and pursuing assets and records of the Estate, coordinating ongoing investigations with various governmental authorities, and communicating with investor victims. This work was necessary to marshal assets of the Estate, determine what assets may be available for potential distribution to claimants, and maximize the final value of any future distribution.

#### A. The Receiver's Investigation

- 6. During the Second Fee Period, the Receiver Team continued to work diligently with the United States Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC") and the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") to investigate potential assets and records of the Estate.<sup>2</sup> The Receiver Team also continued to work with the CFTC and SEC to communicate with foreign authorities and coordinate ongoing investigations around the world. These efforts helped the Receiver conduct his own investigation to pursue assets and records as efficiently as possible. These efforts also furnished helpful information to foreign authorities and assisted their efforts to recover foreign funds or other assets that were procured through apparent acts of fraud.
- 7. The Receiver Team also made substantial progress in the Receiver's investigation of records that formerly belonged to Defendants. For example, the Receiver Team secured and imaged electronic devices from certain Defendants to recover data, review pertinent information and further the Receiver's investigation. The Receiver Team also recovered and reviewed additional records from a Defendant's accountant, which assisted the Receiver's efforts to locate

potential assets of the Estate. Additionally, the Receiver Team obtained and reviewed files, records, and related documents from the former United States attorneys of a foreign Defendant. This process included interviews of the former attorneys to discuss the information contained in those materials. The information gathered from these attorneys has been instrumental to the Receiver's investigation and efforts to marshal potential assets of the Estate.

## B. The Receiver's Recovery of Assets and Records

- 8. During the Second Fee Period, the Receiver Team also made substantial progress in recovering assets and records of the Estate. For example, the Receiver Team continued to lead negotiations for the return of \$750,000 in funds that were received by Defendant Elevation Group, Inc. ("Elevation Group") as commissions for membership fees paid to ProphetMax by certain of Elevation Group's clients.<sup>3</sup> The Receiver Team ultimately drafted a letter agreement concerning the terms of these payments, which resulted in a substantial recovery for the Estate.
- 9. The Receiver Team also continued negotiations with a domestic Defendant to maintain and preserve the Defendant's real and personal property. This process included negotiating, drafting and filing a motion with the Court to seek temporary relief from the Court's Order. *See* Unopposed Joint Motion for Defendant Joel Friant's Temporary Relief from Statutory Restraining Order [Docket No. 26].
- 10. Finally, during the course of the Receiver's investigation, the Receiver Team continued to draft and send notices of the Receiver and the Estate to persons and financial entities that may retain assets or records of the Estate. This process included extensive

correspondence with numerous financial entities concerning their obligations to turn over the Estate's assets and records to the Receiver.

## C. The Receiver's Management of the Estate

- 11. During the Second Fee Period, the Receiver Team continued to make progress in recovering and preserving assets of the Estate. As of October 31, 2012, the Estate held \$299,970 of cash in a bank account under the Receiver's sole control (the "Estate Account"). The Estate also held approximately \$2,856 of additional cash or securities in Defendants' frozen accounts in the United States, and additional personal and real property in the United States, including but not limited to an automobile, residential property, and rental property. As of the date of this Motion, the Estate Account holds \$509,909. This increase in funds is largely due to the receipt of additional payments from Elevation Group. The Receiver expects to receive an additional \$150,000 from Elevation Group on or before February 1, 2013.
- 12. The domestic funds and other assets that have been recovered are in addition to any assets that may be received from foreign jurisdictions. The Receiver Team will continue to collaborate with foreign authorities to coordinate investigations and explore the potential release of foreign assets to the Receiver for the benefit of the Estate.
- 13. During the Second Fee Period, the Receiver Team also provided timely and important information to the CFTC, SEC, foreign authorities, and the general public, including investor victims. For example, the Receiver Team continued to review and respond to a declining number of investor inquiries about this action, the Estate and related matters through the Receiver's public email account, receiver@prophetmaxreceiveship.com, the Estate's website, www.prophetmaxreceivership.com, the Estate's Facebook page, "ProphetMax Receivership," and other social media forums. The Receiver Team also continued to update the Estate's website to provide additional information concerning this action and the Estate.

#### III. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL TO PAY FEES AND EXPENSES FOR SECOND FEE PERIOD

14. As set forth below, the Receiver respectfully requests the Court's approval to pay total interim fees of \$188,844.50 and expenses of \$6,883.65 for the Second Fee Period.

# A. The Court Should Approve the Payment of All Reasonable and Necessary Professional Fees and Expenses

determine whether the time spent, services performed, expenses incurred, and hourly rates charged are reasonable and necessary according to the following "Johnson" factors established by the Fifth Circuit: (1) the time and labor required for the litigation; (2) the novelty and complication of the issues; (3) the skill required to properly litigate the issues; (4) whether the attorney was precluded from other employment by the acceptance of this case; (5) the attorney's customary fee; (6) whether the fee is fixed or contingent; (7) whether the client or the circumstances imposed time limitations; (8) the amount involved and the results obtained; (9) the experience, reputation, and ability of the attorney; (10) the "undesirability" of the case; (11) the nature and length of the attorney-client relationship; and (12) awards in similar cases. *See Johnson v. Georgia Highway Exp., Inc.*, 488 F.2d 714, 717-19 (5th Cir. 1974). For a detailed discussion of the Johnson factors, see the Receiver's First Fee Application pp. 7-10.

# B. The Fees and Expenses are Reasonable and Necessary

16. To limit fees and expenses, the Receiver retained a small team of qualified professionals with the special expertise necessary to help the Receiver fulfill his Court-ordered duties. *See Johnson*, 488 F.2d at 718. Additionally, the Receiver and his professionals have carefully coordinated tasks to communicate effectively and manage the Estate efficiently without duplicating efforts. *See Aquacell Batteries, Inc.*, No. 6:07-cv-608-Orl-22DAB, 2008 WL 276026, \*3 (M.D. Fla. Jan. 31, 2008) ("Billing judgment means . . . knowing how to properly

staff a matter, in proportion to the task at hand."); *SEC v. Mobley*, No. 00 CV 1316, 2000 WL 1702024, \*2 (S.D.N.Y. Nov. 13, 2000) (awarding fees and noting that receiver was adhering to his duties effectively where he employed a core group of five attorneys and one paralegal, and specialists as required). Here, the time spent, services performed, hourly rates charged, and expenses incurred by the Receiver and his professionals were not only reasonable, they were essential for the Receiver to perform his Court-ordered duties.

# a. The Receiver and the Law Firm of Hohmann, Taube & Summers, L.L.P.4

- Estate averaging approximately 4.1 hours per business day. He also provided an additional 0.9 hours of services over the weekends during this period. At Hohmann, Taube & Summers, L.L.P., the senior associate and junior associate who served as counsel for the Receiver devoted an average of 5.3 and 4.2 hours, respectively, per business day to the Estate, and an additional 0.4 and 2.2 hours, respectively, over the weekends during this period. Paralegals and other support staff also devoted approximately 207 total hours in services to the Estate. *See* Exhibit A. Overall, these services equate to an effective billing rate of \$360.59 per hour.
  - 18. The following summary provides a general description of these services:
    - i. Participating in informational conferences with Defendants and their counsel, negotiating and securing Defendants' production of electronic devices and other records, and negotiating an agreed stay of Defendant Michael Dillard's related class action lawsuit.
    - ii. Negotiating and drafting a letter agreement for Elevation Group's payment of ProphetMax commissions to the Estate.
  - iii. Assisting ongoing investigations by the CFTC and SEC, including reviewing and analyzing documents and other information obtained during these investigations.
  - iv. Communicating and coordinating with foreign authorities to further foreign investigations and assist the potential seizure of foreign assets.

- v. Communicating with investors concerning this action, the Receiver, the Estate, and investment matters via telephone, email, the Estate's website, the Estate's Facebook page, and other social media forums.
- vi. Drafting and filing notices of the Receiver and the Estate in federal courts by filing copies of the CFTC's complaint and the Court's Order.
- vii. Drafting and sending notices of the Receiver and the Estate to certain persons and financial institutions identified in the investigation, including letters authorizing the release of Defendants' assets, information, and records, and correspondence with numerous financial entities concerning their obligations to turn over such assets and records to the Receiver.
- viii. Correspondence with a domestic financial institution to investigate international funds transfers involving IB Capital, an alleged counterparty in the fraud.
- ix. Facilitating services provided by Flashback Data to image Defendants' electronic devices, analyze the data acquired, and review pertinent information.
- x. Facilitating services provided by Rainmaker Document Technologies, Inc. to manage documents and electronic information, including scanning paper documents, processing electronic documents, creating load files, databases and document productions, analyzing native data, and duplicating electronic media.
- xi. Negotiating and reviewing the production of files, records, and other documents from the former attorneys of a foreign Defendant, including related interviews.
- xii. Coordinating with the Internal Revenue Service and a tax accountant to obtain taxpayer identification information for the Estate and open the Estate Account.
- xiii. Participating in the litigation of this action, including negotiating agreements, reviewing, drafting and filing various court papers, and conferences with counsel regarding Defendants' compliance obligations under the Court's Order.
- 19. The Receiver believes the services rendered during the Second Fee Period will reflect the peak of activity for the Receiver Team during the life of the Estate. Despite this peak in activity, the Receiver significantly reduced his average time on the Estate from 6.1 hours per business day in the First Fee Period to only 4.1 hours in this period, a decrease of 33%. The Receiver Team also significantly lowered its effective billing rate from \$429.56 per hour in the First Fee Period to only \$360.59 in this period, a decrease of 16%. Additionally, the Receiver and his legal counsel continue to render their services to the Estate at a 15% discount to their customary billing rates. This discount has produced a \$48,676.13 reduction in fees incurred by the Estate from September 18, 2012 through October 31, 2012.

20. The Receiver believes future monthly fees and expenses for services will decrease significantly over the remaining life of the Estate. For example, in the month of November 2012, fees and expenses incurred by the Estate decreased 37% to \$120,291.39. In December 2012, total fees and expenses fell again by 27% to \$87,577.11. These favorable reductions in fees and expenses illustrate the Receiver's efforts to minimize costs by managing the Estate as efficiently as possible.

21. Additionally, as noted in the Receiver's First Interim Status Report, the Receiver and his legal counsel are currently adjusting staffing to further reduce fees and expenses, as the Receiver believes he has now identified the substantial majority of assets that may be recovered by the Estate. *See* First Interim Status Report of the Receiver of the ProphetMax Receivership Estate ¶ 27 [Docket No. 50]. As a result of these staffing adjustments, the Receiver expects fees and expenses to continue to fall and then stabilize in 2013.

22. The fees and expenses charged by Hohmann, Taube & Summers, L.L.P. during the Second Fee Period includes all compensation requested for the Receiver's services and the services of his legal professionals. *See* Exhibit A. The Receiver requests the Court's approval to pay for these services totaling \$188,844.50 in fees and \$2,445.10 in expenses because the fees and expenses were reasonable and necessary for the Receiver to fulfill his Court-ordered duties.

# b. Flashback Data<sup>5</sup>

As of October 31, 2012, Flashback Data had collected over 4 terabytes of electronically stored information from Defendants, including email correspondence, Skype transcripts and financial records. As reflected in the invoice attached as Exhibit B to this Motion, Flashback

Data charged \$2,599.60 for these services during the Second Fee Period. These charges are not included in Exhibit A. The Receiver requests the Court's approval to pay for these services because they were reasonable and necessary for the Receiver to fulfill his Court-ordered duties.

#### c. Rainmaker Document Technologies, Inc.

Rainmaker Document Technologies, Inc. ("Rainmaker") has over 75 years of experience in managing legal documents. Rainmaker's services helped the Receiver Team manage the documents and electronic information necessary to pursue assets and records of the Estate, including scanning paper documents, processing electronic information, creating load files, databases and document productions, analyzing native data, and duplicating electronic media. As reflected in the invoice attached as Exhibit C to this Motion, Rainmaker charged \$1,838.95 for these services during the Second Fee Period. These charges are not included in Exhibit A. The Receiver requests the Court's approval to pay for these services because they were reasonable and necessary for the Receiver to fulfill his Court-ordered duties.

#### IV. CONCLUSION

As discussed above, the fees and expenses requested in this Motion were both reasonable and necessary for the Receiver to fulfill his Court-ordered duties. The Receiver requests that the Court enter the proposed Order filed with this Motion to approve the payment of \$195,728.15 in total fees and expenses incurred from October 1, 2012 through October 31, 2012.


