



Have you seen red kites in Northumberland or

Durham recently?



... then please do let us know via our website (see below). This is even more important if you see them from now until early June as the red kites are nesting.

You may be interested in becoming a member of the Friends of Red Kites (£7.00 pa for an individual or £10.00 pa for a family) and, perhaps, even join our monitoring team where training and supervision will be provided; small teams go out regularly to locate and check on the red kite territories in the Derwent Valley. This starts in early March, with finding the red kites' nests, and then their subsequent monitoring until the chicks are ringed and wing-tagged, before they fledge, in early June. We also check on the red kite roosts from September to January.
