RE: Voluntary SAD

Dear Sherman Lake Homeowner,

We are sharing a very rough schedule with you as we currently understand the timeline for the voluntary SAD. GLSWA still has approximately 40% of homeowners to contact before the end of April to obtain the material quantities for the project. In May, the voluntary assessment educational piece will be communicated to the lake residents. This will come in the form of a public meeting. Documentation will be executed in June and bond sales in late July or early August. Finalization of the financing will take place mid-September. We intend to get 30-40% of the homes connected before winter sets in. Priority and scheduling will be determined in July/August by GLSWA and its engineer.

A couple of points: Early site visits allow those with inadequate electric service to upgrade prior to their installation. This is a cost that cannot go on the voluntary SAD. There are some homes that need immediate attention and will be scheduled first. Any impact on concrete and asphalt will be set for next Spring so that we don't have to maintain those areas through the snow removal season.
