Meeting Minutes – December 9, 2025

Attendance

23 community members were in attendance, including 2 online participants.

Highlights

- Raphael Prophett emphasized the urgent need for North Fairmount residents to file for precinct executive positions, as the community currently lacks political representation in the Democratic Party.
 - Officer Gottmann presented a crime report noting an uptick in petty thefts typical for the holiday season. Residents were encouraged to secure vehicles, use tracking tools, and remain vigilant. New police recruits will be joining the district soon.
 - Brenda Waldron of Millville Health Center shared that affordable healthcare—including sliding scale services and dental care—remains available, regardless of insurance status. Brenda can be reached at 513-352-3194 (desk) or 513-806-6468 (work cell).
 - Two surveys were conducted: a Traffic Survey and a Committee Interest Survey. A sign-up sheet was also circulated for the Senior Fruit Box Distribution on December 27.
 - Trista, President of the Beekman Community Market, promoted “Breakfast with Santa” and the monthly market. Trish from Price Hill Library highlighted December programming and resources.
 - The council discussed clearer communication for flyers, volunteer hour tracking, and food access program management.
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Treasurer’s Report

- NSP Report (Tricia): Projects funded by the Neighborhood Support Program, as voted on by the community, were reviewed.
 - Membership Drive: \$3,000 allocated, \$2,817.37 spent, ~\$182 remaining
 - Stakeholder Engagement: \$2,000 allocated, \$1,768.68 spent
 - Holiday Community Carnival: \$5,000 allocated, \$4,129.91 spent
 - The Treasurer typically reports a running total of dues collected at each meeting. However, the updated amount was not available at the December 9, 2025 meeting.
 - The total bank/account balance was not explicitly stated during the meeting. For the exact balance, members may consult the upcoming final treasurer’s report or contact the treasurer directly.
 - Paperwork for the Neighborhood Support Program money was still being finalized (due December 15).
