



# ADMISSIONS PROCESS

**Introduction:**

Reach works with mainstream, special and local authorities to provide outreach service to students that are on the verge of exclusions, managed moves, hard to reach, anxious school refusers or waiting alternative placement due to complex behaviour needs. Reach also provides high level family support that is commissioned by local authorities.

## **Reach provides 2 different services:**

### ***Outreach for KS2, KS3 and KS4***

Mentoring and direct work with individual students, counseling and family support.

### **Turnaround project for KS3 and KS4**

Students are referred for a time limited period of 12 weeks from mainstream schools.

Students remain on their school roll while at turnaround project and REACH will call daily to advice on attendance.

Please note: the referring mainstream school retains the responsibility for starting and maintaining the EHCP.

## **Referral process:**

Once referral form has been received contact will be made within 48hr and initial visit and within 7 days.

Outreach service varies in prices from £45 per hour - £65 per hour depending on complexity of student

Turnaround project is £4000 for 12 weeks with supported reintegration, pick up and drop offs and lunches included.
