

The Georgetown Rotary Scholarship

1. Eligibility: The applicant must be a resident of Scott County, Kentucky, a graduating student from a Scott County school, and enrolled on a full-time basis in the fall at a public, technical, or private community college or university. Applicants with a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale will be given priority consideration.
2. Criteria for Selection: Primary criteria used to select the scholarship recipients include (in priority order); the need for assistance, proof of and commitment to academic achievement, letters of reference, written essay, and extra-curricular school and community activities.
3. Reference Letters: Two (2) sealed letters of reference are required. One letter must be from a school official familiar with the applicant's abilities and extra-curricular activities; the other letter may come from a person of the applicant's choice. Each letter must contain the name and address of its author. The letters should contain a statement by the author as to how long they have known the applicant and in what capacity and a general statement as to the applicant's motivation, initiative, dependability, ability to communicate and other characteristics the author believes indicates a successful completion of the applicant's educational goals. Each page of the reference letter should contain the applicant's name.
4. Transcript: The applicant's high school counselor must make available an official copy of the applicant's transcript. If not included with the application, it must be specifically directed to the address below.
5. Recipient of the \$2,000 scholarship from each high school will be remitted directly to the recipient before the school year starts in the fall.
6. Deadline instructions: All applications must be emailed to Katy@pratherteam.com or you may mail to Rotary Club P.O. Box 916, Georgetown, KY 40324. All applications including transcripts, reference letters and any other pertinent information must be postmarked by April 30th. Any applications that are incomplete or are not received by the deadline will **not** be accepted.
