How are Children Affected?

Several social, economic and environmental factors contribute to children becoming vulnerable. In a diverse country like India, these contributing factors are even more complex and longstanding while the interventions remain simplistic. “Extreme poverty” still remains the key factor. The following outlines some of the other factors identified in and through our work:

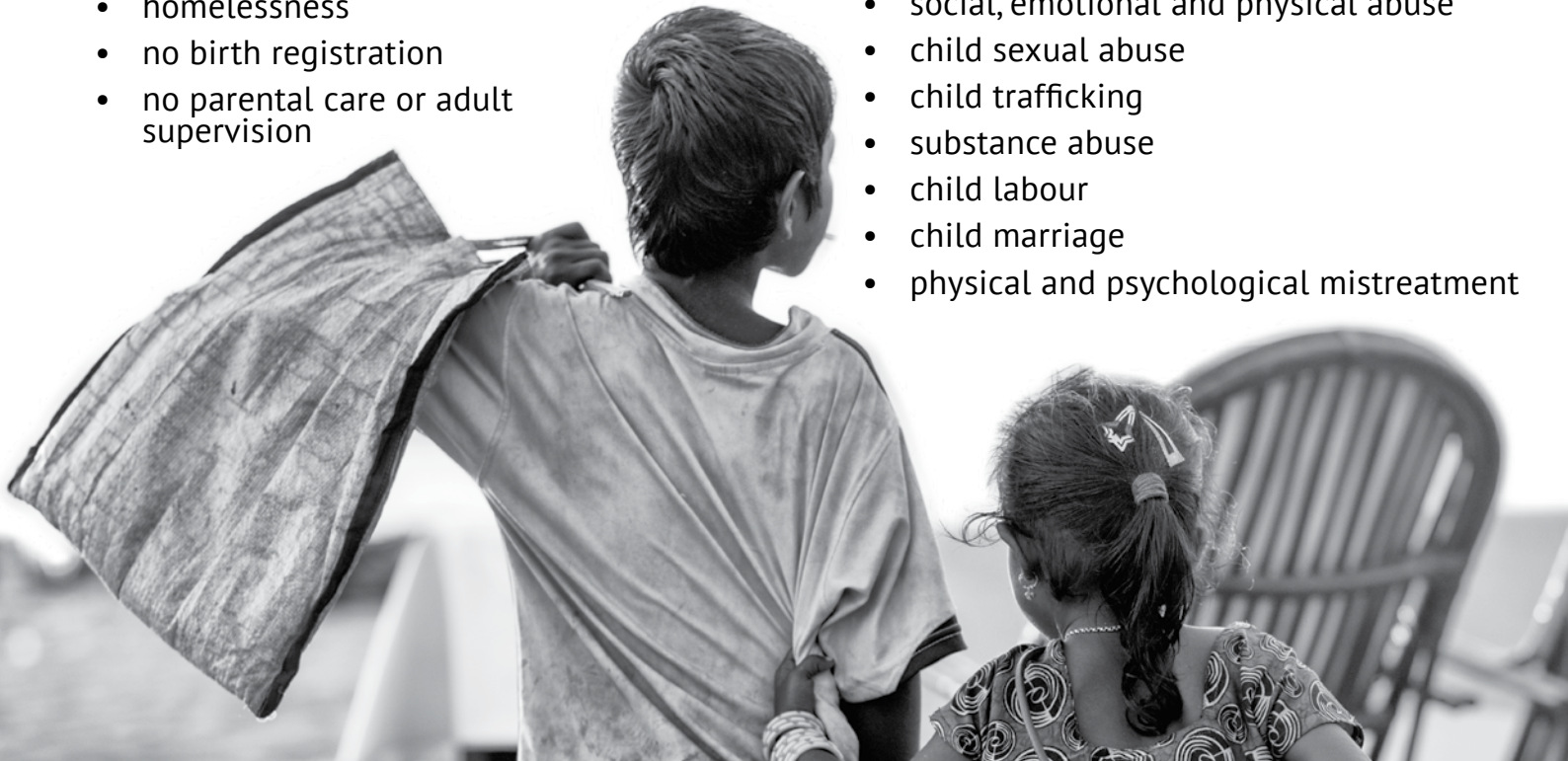
- economic crisis and unemployment
- gender discrimination
- children whose parents have both died
- children with a single parent
- conflict between parents or divorce
- corruption
- accidents
- being lost from parents
- imprisonment of parents
- natural disasters like famine, drought and floods
- diseases like HIV-AIDS
- children with disabilities
- inadequate alternative care



Why the Hope House?

Children are the most vulnerable members in our society. They remain underserved and unaware of their basic rights. Many are prone to become victims of illegal and inhumane exploitation such as:

- abandonment
- homelessness
- no birth registration
- no parental care or adult supervision
- malnourishment
- social, emotional and physical abuse
- child sexual abuse
- child trafficking
- substance abuse
- child labour
- child marriage
- physical and psychological mistreatment
