# David Guterson

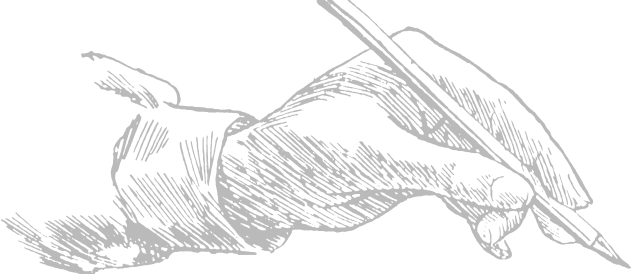
