LOGLINE

Trapped in a strange surveillance-filled apartment and decaying by the minute, a young man relies on a cryptic series of vaccines to slow his demise while plotting revenge on the unseen force controlling his fate.

SYNOPSIS

Will awakes in a twin bed in a small, neat and nearly empty apartment. He is being watched.

He suddenly discovers that there is something off about him. He's not well.

He's decomposing. And quickly.

Will tries to fend off the decay with a mysterious medication he discovers in the bathroom. He pleads for help to a silent viewer at the other end of the surveillance cameras in the apartment.

But Will soon realizes he's on his own. And things are about to get worse. For him - and for anyone he crosses paths with on his dark and unsettling journey.

THE HISTORY

The Itch is a cautionary tale that probes our fears of death and loss, while reminding us how greed and jealousy can turn someone into the monster of their own story.

With this short, I wanted to explore the visceral fear of losing control over one's own body and mind.

Inspired by my love of psychological horror and visual storytelling, I set out to create a film that confronts the audience with the unknown and the unseen. The apartment becomes a character in itself, a space that both traps and transforms, reflecting the protagonist's unraveling state. I hope 'The Itch' leaves viewers questioning not just what is real, but the lengths we'll go to preserve our sense of self.





NATHAN NAGVAJARA AS *WILL*

Nate is an American actor and comedian, currently based in Chicago, Illinois. He's worked in the entertainment industry for his entire adult life, has produced and starred in several shorts and currently tours the country as a stand-up comedian.



JOHN POTVIN AS *ROGER*

John hails from Boston Massachusetts and has been working in the film industry for over six years, starting on a high school theater stage at seventeen. He has since starred in over sixty short and feature length films. He's won several awards including Best Actor at the Golden Hour Film Festival for the historical short film The Pines.
