Standard Vehicle Eligibility Criteria

Eligible

- ✓ No check-engine or airbag lights
- ✓ No bad tires (<5/32 tread)
- ✓ No bad brakes (<4mm pads, warped rotors)
- ✓ No failing major components like suspension, steering, transmission, A/C
- ✓ No major leaks oil, steering, transmission, coolant
- ✓ No permanent foul odors or stains
- ✓ No major body damage or cracked windshields
- ✓ No broken or inoperable electronic components

Dealer gets seller approval to perform "deferred maintenance" items and reconditioning to make vehicle front-line ready to same level as owned-cars.

Absolute Ineligible

- × Inoperable engine
- × Bad transmission
- × Frame damage
- × Structural damage
- × Flood
- Manufacturer buyback (lemon)
- × Inoperable odometer
- ➤ Branded titles salvage, rebuilt
- × Total insurance loss
- × Airbag deployed (current or previous)
