LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear friends in Christ,

I am writing this during my last week as the pastor at American Lutheran, Jesup and Zion Lutheran, Jubilee. On May 31, I begin serving as the Director for Evangelical Mission, which is an Assistant to the Bishop position in the Northeastern Iowa Synod. I am sad to leave these two lovely congregations and yet also excited for what lies ahead.

My family and I plan to move to Waverly, where the Northeastern Iowa Synod Office is located, but as of this writing, we do not have a house in Waverly to move to yet, so we plan to rent the parsonage from American Lutheran for a few months this summer. After May 29, I will no longer be your pastor, so I will not perform any pastoral acts (preaching, worship leadership, funerals, weddings, hospital visits, etc). However, you can still say "hi" if you see us around!

I am incredibly grateful for my time with you. These last couple of years have been incredibly stressful for everyone, and I'm very grateful that both congregations approached the changes necessitated by the pandemic with grace, flexibility, and understanding. Both congregations approached the pastor sharing contract with grace and flexibility as well, and I think that has helped the partnership between congregations to flourish. I am grateful to have served two congregations that see that there are things we can do with others that we couldn't do by ourselves. You recognize the importance of connection to the wider church within the ELCA and with other denominations. You are very generous with supporting the mission of God beyond the walls of the congregation, supporting ministries like Camp EWALU, Lutheran Services in Iowa, and Food Pantries.

I have noticed over the past year that the American and Zion Jubilee have different congregational personalities, and strengths in different areas. As these two congregations begin the call process together, I would encourage you to reflect on the strengths of the different congregations, and think about whether there are ways that each congregation can enrich the ministry of the other congregation.

God is truly at work in, among, and through the people of American and Zion Jubilee. I feel very blessed to have been able to serve as your pastor!

American Lutheran Church April Council Meeting April 11, 2022

President Sue Hoey called the meeting to order both in person and electronically on Zoom at 6:34 pm. Present were Pastor Kristen Corr Rod, Sue Hoey, Maureen Even, Loren Corkery, and Shirley Bergman. Joining on Zoom were Christa Leach, Beth Stanek, Mitchell Hayek, and Sheila Collins.

Sue Hoey led devotions.

Mitchell Hayek made a motion to confirm Cindy Gosse as council Treasurer effective May 1, 2022 to complete the term voluntarily held by Loren Corkery. Second by Maureen Even. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – The checking account balance at the end of March was \$9,864.62. In March, \$8,000.00 was transferred from checking to the General Savings and Emergency Fund and \$600.00 was transferred to the Sabbatical Fund. No fund transfers will be made this month since the balance is below \$10,000.00. Maureen Even made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second by Christa Leach. Motion carried.

<u>Secretary's Report</u> – Maureen Even made a motion to approve the Secretary's Report as written. Second by Christa Leach. Motion carried.

Committee Reports Note: Full committee reports are available in a binder outside the secretary's office.

<u>Abundant Life</u> - There will be a fellowship time with donuts and coffee at 8:15 am prior to the Easter worship service at 9:00 am.

<u>Hospitality</u> – The new Midweek Boost food, fellowship, and devotional time will be April 20 from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

Memorial - No report.

Parish Ed – A congregational potluck picnic will be held after worship on May 1.

Presidents – No concerns.

<u>Property</u> – Grell Roofing and Karr Tuckpointing are assessing needs to the church building. Stored items at the Thompson building have been posted for sale, disposed of, or moved to ALC for storage. The ALC Fellowship Room storage has been cleaned. Church keys have been inventoried and numbered. ALC stored items in the parsonage garage need to be sorted.

Scholarship – The ALC EPIC scholarship continues for Alyssa Hoey, a Wartburg sophomore.

<u>Technology</u> – The new video live streaming equipment has been installed.

<u>Worship and Music</u> – The Maundy Thursday ecumenical service on April 14 will include a community choir directed by Jim Thompson of First United Presbyterian Church. Thank-you to the Hoey family, Pastor Kristen and Charlie Rod, Dawn Quackenbush, Shirley Bergman, and Marcia and Scott Riggs for providing special music for worship. Hymns have been chosen through April 24, 2022.

<u>Youth</u> – The ALC and ZLC Youth Mission Trip to Milwaukee, WI is June 6-9, 2022. There will be an EWALU workday on May 7, 2022 open to any volunteers.

I attended a Food Pantry Board meeting. I attended Synod Day of Renewal. I attended 2 Synod Council meetings. I led 3 communion classes for 3rd-6th graders at ALC and Jubilee. I'm hoping to schedule a

communion class for interested K-2nd graders sometime after Easter but before the end of the school year. In the next month: On the afternoon of April 14, I will be leading a Maundy Thursday worship service with communion at the care center in La Porte City. On the evening of April 14, ALC will host the ecumenical Maundy Thursday service. On the evening of April 15, UMC will host the ecumenical Good Friday service. Our first Midweek Boost service will be April 20 at 6pm. The Ministerial will meet on April 27 to plan the Summer Food Program and Community-Wide VBS. Dates for VBS are Aug 14-17, and the theme is Food Truck Party. I will be in Des Moines on May 2-3 for our final retreat for the Moses Project Continuing Education Cohort.
